THE LEAD

Iowa State (0-1, 0-0 Big 12) opens Big 12 play in its first road test of the season at TCU (0-0, 0-0 Big 12). The Cyclones have defeated the Horned Frogs twice in the last three seasons. ISU's lone victory over TCU in Ft. Worth was in 2012 (37-23), TCU's first season in the league. ISU has yet to win a Big 12-opener in the Matt Campbell era (2016-) and its last win in its first league tilt was a 38-13 win over Kansas to begin the 2015 Big 12 campaign.

KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State hopes to bounce back after suffering a 31-14 setback vs. Louisiana in its home-opener on Sept. 12.
- The Cyclones outgained the Ragin' Cajuns, 303-272, but three big plays doomed ISU. The Cyclones allowed a 95-yard kickoff return, an 83-yard punt return and a 78-yard pass play which all resulted in touchdowns.
- ISU returns 14 players who have earned All-Big 12 recognition, including seven first- or second-teamers: Chase Allen (TE), JaQuan Bailey (DE), Kene Nwangwu (KR), Charlie Kolar (TE), Greg Eithworth (DB), Brock Purdy (QB) and Breece Hall (RB).
- Seven Cyclones have appeared on 13 national award preseason watch lists.
- Iowa State was ranked in the preseason AP poll for the second season in a row.
- The loss to Louisiana dropped ISU's record to 12-5 in Jack Trice Stadium as a ranked opponent.
- Breece Hall ran for 103 yards vs. Louisiana en route to his fifth career 100-yard rushing game.

MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM



MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM

MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium has proven to be one of the most outstanding football structures in the country in its 46-year existence. With its remarkable sight lines and numerous renovations throughout the years to enhance the game day atmosphere, the stadium ranks as one of the nation's best football venues.

The 61,500-seat stadium is the third-largest in the Big 12 Conference. Construction on the stadium started on Oct. 26, 1973 with the first game in the facility played on Sept. 20, 1975. It was officially dedicated as Jack Trice Stadium in 1997 in honor of Jack Trice, Iowa State's first African-American student-athlete who died tragically from injuries in a football game in 1923. Iowa State is the only FBS school in the nation to have a stadium name dedicated to an African-American.



WHO WAS JACK TRICE?

Jack Trice was born in Hiram, Ohio in 1902. Trice attended East Tech High School in Cleveland, where he was a star athlete. When his football coach, Sam Willaman, was named head coach at Iowa State, Trice and six other athletes followed him west, as Trice became the first African-American student-athlete in Iowa State history. Trice majored in animal husbandry and his goal was to settle in the South after his graduation and help the black farmers of that area. He was a very studious young man and despite his participation in intercollegiate athletics, Trice managed to pass 45 college credits with a 90 percent average. Because there were no athletic

scholarships granted in those days, he worked odd jobs to finance his education and support his wife and mother.

On the gridiron, Trice was a stellar performer in the interior line in 1923. His promising career abruptly ended, however. Trice played in the season-opener, a 14-6 win over Simpson in Ames. He traveled to Minneapolis the following weekend to face a strong Gopher squad. It was during intermission that Trice began to complain of a sore left shoulder, but nevertheless, returned to action in the second half. Midway through the third quarter, a frustrated Minnesota team ran a play off left tackle. Trice immediately saw that he wouldn't be able to reach the ball carrier, so he threw himself in front of the Minnesota interference in a roll block. He was toppled over on his back and trampled on.

Trice wanted to continue playing but never returned to the game. Doctors at a Minneapolis hospital allowed Trice to return to Ames with the team, which lost the game 20-17. They declared his condition not so serious. Trice rode back on a pullman coach. He rested his body on a straw mattress and was immediately taken to the university hospital upon his arrival in Ames. There, doctors discovered a broken collarbone Trice had sustained during the first half of the contest. His condition worsened as he developed respiratory problems Sunday afternoon, and a stomach specialist from Des Moines was summoned. Dr. Oliver Fay decided that surgery would be too risky, so no operation was performed.

At 3 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 8, 1923, Jack Trice died of hemorrhaged lungs and internal bleeding throughout the abdomen. The following Tuesday, classes

were postponed and a funeral service was held before 4,000 students and faculty members on the central grounds of campus.

A letter written by Jack Trice to himself on the eve of the Minnesota game was found in his coat pocket the day of his funeral. The contents of that letter were divulged before the 4,000 mourners. It read:

"My thoughts just before the first real college game of my life: The honor of my race, family and self is at stake. Everyone is expecting me to do big things. I will. My whole body and soul are to be thrown recklessly about the field. Every time the ball is snapped, I will be trying to do more than my part. Fight low, with your eyes open and toward the play. Watch out for crossbucks and reverse end runs. Be on your toes every minute if you expect to make good. Jack."

A memorial scholarship was created, and a memorial to Trice is located on the east concourse of the football stadium as you enter the Jack Trice Club. A statue in his honor was unveiled in 1987 and currently resides on central campus.

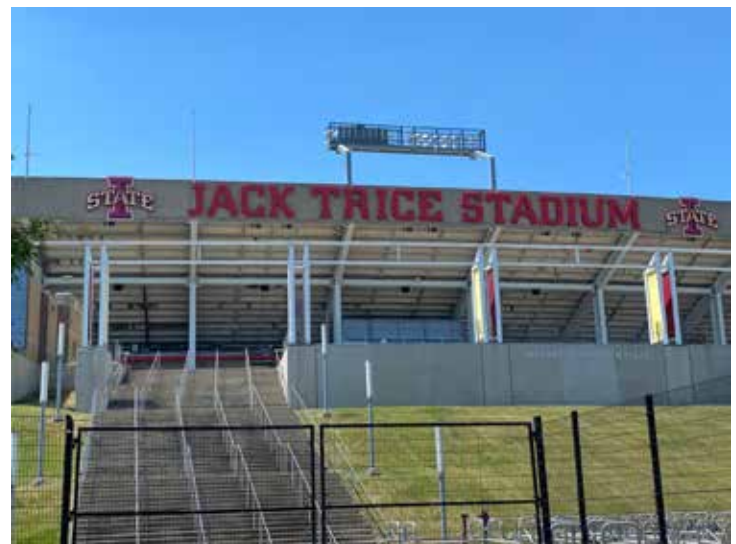
Iowa State unveiled its new stadium in 1975 and it was originally named Cyclone Stadium. Gradually, the Trice story started to become more prevalent.

A strong push from students and alumni to dedicate the stadium in honor of Trice gained traction in the early 1980s. Iowa State President Dr. Robert Parks announced the facility name would change to Cyclone Stadium at Jack Trice Field prior to the 1984 season.

A groundswell of support for Trice continued, however. Supporters felt Trice's name should be the primary focus of the stadium. Finally, in 1997, President Dr. Martin Jischke officially dedicated Iowa State's football playground as Jack Trice Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT

- Iowa State lost its season-opener to Louisiana (Sept. 12), 31-14, in front of an empty Jack Trice Stadium.
- The Cyclones were doomed by three big touchdown plays in the game that shifted momentum: 95-yard kickoff return, 78-yard completion and 83-yard punt return.
- ISU led at the break, 14-10, but UL took control late in the third quarter with a 78-yard TD toss followed by an Eric Garror 83-yard punt return for a TD.
- The last time ISU gave up a punt return for a TD was vs. Baylor in 2013.
- In the 52 games in the Matt Campbell era, the Cyclones have had just one punt return and one kickoff return for a TD.
- The Cyclones also lost the turnover battle at 0-2.
- Since 1996, teams that have allowed a punt return for a TD, a kickoff return for a TD and lost the turnover margin by two or more are 0-18.
- ISU outgained UL, 303-272, marking the 11th time since the 2017 season where the Cyclone defense held an opponent to under 300 yards of offense.
- DE Will McDonald led the Cyclones with a pair of sacks to give him seven sacks in the last five games dating back to 2019. He also had four tackles.
- DL Joshua Bailey tallied four tackles and 2.0 TFL to help the Cyclones record 7.0 TFL for the game.
- DE JaQuan Bailey was solid in his first game action since suffering a season-ending injury in the fourth game of the 2019 season. Bailey had five tackles and a TFL to increase his career TFL total to 32.5, tying for fourth all-time in school history.

- Hall tallied his 10th career rushing TD and RB Kene Nwangwu notched his first career rushing TD with a one-yard plunge in the second quarter.

CAMPBELL ONE OF ISU'S BEST COACHES

- Head coach Matt Campbell has turned Iowa State into a winner in his tenure with the Cyclones.
- Campbell has a 26-26 overall record for a .500 winning percentage.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The Cyclone defense has improved dramatically since 2017. With the ability to use multiple formations without substitutions, ISU DC Jon Heacock has created a defensive master plan that other teams have mimicked.
- Iowa State's 85 TFL in 2019 ranked third in school history and 28 sacks was sixth-best total in school history. ISU's 6.5 TFL per game average ranked fifth in the Big 12 and 36th nationally.
- ISU was third in the league in scoring

defense in 2019 at 25.9. ISU has finished in the top-three in the Big 12 in scoring defense in each of the last three seasons.

- Iowa State opened the season by holding a high-powered Louisiana offense to just 272 yards.
- The Cyclones have limited opponents to under 300 yards of total offense 11 times since 2017.
- ISU's defense is allowing 17.0 points per game this season not including non-offensive scores.
- The Cyclones had three sacks and 7.0 TFL vs. Louisiana.
- Will McDonald posted 2.0 sacks to give him 7.0 in his last five games dating back to last season. McDonald is currently second in the NCAA in sacks per game.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Iowa State's offense returns 10 players who have started five or more games in their careers and a combined 118 starts.
- Six players are back who earned all-conference recognition, including First-Team All-Big 12 tight end Charlie Kolar (junior) and second-teamers Brock Purdy (QB), a junior, and Breece Hall (RB), a sophomore.
- Also back is Second-Team All-Big 12 tight end Chase Allen (senior) and HM All-Big 12 offensive lineman Trevor Downing (sophomore), who was a freshman All-American in 2019.
- The Cyclones outgained (303-272) and outrushed (158-118) Louisiana in the season-opener.

JUST THE FACTS ON BROCK PURDY

- Brock Purdy is 14-9 as the Cyclone QB, including a 11-5 mark vs. Big 12 teams.

- Purdy, who is a member of five preseason watch lists, was a Second-Team All-Big 12 selection in 2019, the first Cyclone QB since Seneca Wallace (2002) to earn first- or second-team All-Big 12 accolades.
- In ISU's last 23 games (Purdy era), the Cyclones are averaging 421.9 yards of total offense (9,704) and 30.9 points (710).
- Currently owns 21 school records (game, season, career).
- Purdy had one of the most prolific seasons by an Iowa State signal-caller in school history in 2019, setting season school records in passing yardage (3,982), passing TDs (27), completions (312), total offense (4,231) and 300-yard passing games (6). He ranked in the top-6 nationally in passing yardage (4th, 306.3), total offense (5th, 325.5) and completions (6th, 24.0).

- Purdy has never had a turnover in the red zone in his career: 44-74 passing (59.5%) for 340 yards, 23 TD passes, 109 rushing yards, 12 rushing TDs, 0 interceptions, 0 fumbles.
- Owns 13 passes of 50+ yards in his career.
- Had at least two TDs (rushing or passing) in 17 of last 23 games.
- Led ISU to four 4th-quarter comeback victories in career (Kansas State in 2018; UNI, Texas, Kansas in 2019).
- 10 times in the last 23 games Purdy has completed 70 pct. of his passes (minimum 20 attempts).
- Has five games with four or more TDs responsible in his career: (2018, Oklahoma State, 5; 2019, ULM, 6, TCU, 4, Oklahoma, 6, Kansas, 5).
- Owns four of the top 11 passing games in school history (No. 3 435 vs. ULM; No. 6 382 vs. Oklahoma State; No. 8 378 vs. Texas Tech; and No. 11 372 vs. Kansas).

KOLAR LEADS TALENTED TIGHT END UNIT

- Junior tight end Charlie Kolar made history in 2019 by becoming Iowa State's first All-American and Academic All-American, earning Second-Team All-America honors by the FWAA and First-Team Academic All-America accolades by CoSIDA.
- Kolar, who was one of eight semifinalists for the Mackey Award in 2019 and is on the preseason watch list for the award this year, led all Big 12 tight ends in receptions (51), receiving yards (697) and receiving TDs (7) in 2019. His 697 receiving yards broke ISU's season record for tight ends.
- Kolar missed the season-opener while nursing a lower body injury.
- Here is where Kolar ranks among tight ends on ISU's career record list: Receiving Yards (5th, 834), Receiving TDs (T2nd, 10) and Receptions (6th, 62).
- Kolar is among a trio of outstanding tight ends contributing for the Cyclones. Along with seniors Chase Allen (31 catches, 321 yards, 2 TDs) and Dylan Soehner (8 catches, 107 yards, 1 TD), the Cyclone tight end unit has a combined 101 receptions, 1,262 yards and 13 TDs.

BAILEY SHARES CAREER SACK MARK

- Senior JaQuan Bailey will go down as one of the best DEs in Iowa State history. The two-time All-Big 12 choice is a member of the Nagurski Trophy watch list.
- Bailey is back for his fifth season after suffering a season-ending injury in the fourth game of 2019.
- His career 18.5 sacks is tied for first in Iowa State history with Shawn Moorehead (2004-06) and is the third-best active total among FBS players.
- Bailey's 32.5 TFL is tied for fourth all-time in ISU history and ranks fifth among active FBS players.

BREECE "THE BEAST" HALL

- Since Breece Hall took over as ISU's primary ball-carrier in the sixth game of the 2019 season, he has been one of the most productive running backs in the nation.
- During that span (nine games), Hall is averaging 101.8 yards (916), 131.4 scrimmage yards (1,183) with 11 TDs.
- Hall has five 100-yard rushing games during that span, including an 103-yard performance vs. Louisiana in the season-opener.
- In eight of the last nine games, Hall has also gone over 100 yards from scrimmage. Darren Davis was the last Cyclone to produce a similar prolific offensive stretch, clipping 100 all-purpose yards in nine out of 10 games from 1998-99.
- Hall's career 97.46 all-purpose yard average ranks 11th among active NCAA players.

- In 232 career touches, has just one fumble.
- Has posted eight 20+ yard rushes in career.

KENE Nwangwu A RETURN THREAT

- Kene Nwangwu has been one of the most reliable kickoff returners since his rookie season in 2016.
- Nwangwu's career 26.2 kickoff return average ranks third all-time in Iowa State history (minimum 20 returns) and is the third-best total among active NCAA players.
- Nwangwu returned a kickoff for a TD as a rookie in 2016 (West Virginia) and has nine career returns of 40+ yards.
- Nwangwu, who recorded his first career rushing TD vs. Louisiana, is averaging 23.0 yards per kickoff return this season with a long of 34 yards.

PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT SINCE 2017

- Iowa State has registered three-straight winning seasons and appeared in three-straight bowl games for just the second time in school history (2000-02). It was the first time since 1976-78 that Iowa State reeled off three-straight winning seasons.
- Iowa State finished above .500 in conference play in three-straight seasons. ISU has just four winning seasons in league play in the Big 12 era (2000, 2017, 2018, 2019).
- Iowa State tied for third in the Big 12 Conference in the last two seasons, marking just the fourth and fifth time ISU placed third or better in conference play in the last 60 years (1959, 1977, 1978, 2018, 2019).
- Iowa State posted 23 wins from 2017-19, one win shy from the school-record three-year winning stretch (24 wins) from 1976-78.
- Iowa State has appeared in the College Football Playoff rankings in each of the last three seasons, joining Oklahoma as the only two Big 12 teams to do so.
- Iowa State has appeared in the CFP rankings a total of 11 weeks since 2017, ranking third in the Big 12.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

- Won 14 games in Jack Trice Stadium from 2017-19, tying for the most in stadium history in a three-year span (2000-02).
- Tallied six wins over AP Top-25 opponents, tying for the 13th-most nationally since 2017. ISU has 23 victories over AP Top-25 opponents in the 128 years of the program.
- Owns three victories over teams rated in the top-6 nationally since 2017, tying for fourth nationally.
- Owns six victories since 2017 where ISU trailed or was tied in the fourth quarter.

- Since 2017, ISU has been defeated by over 14 points twice (Notre Dame, Louisiana).
- In 8 of ISU's 17 losses since 2017, the Cyclones have led or were tied in the 4th quarter.
- ISU has played in 18 one-score games since 2017.
- The Cyclones have accumulated 6 victories since 2017 where the game was tied or ISU trailed in the 4th quarter.

IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME

- Iowa State has shattered virtually all attendance marks in this decade.
- Over 50,000 fans attended a game in MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium a school-record 59-straight games until the 2020 season-opener when fans were not allowed to attend.

- The top-10 most attended games in school history have occurred since 2011.
- MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium capacity was increased to 61,500 in 2015, making it the third-largest stadium in the Big 12.
- Iowa State ended the 2019 home season by averaging 59,794 fans per game, breaking the school record for best season average in school history.
- ISU tied a school record with six home wins in 2018 and has won 14 games at home since 2017, tying for the best three-year winning stretch in school history.

JACK TRICE PATCHES

- Iowa State will honor its past and raise awareness for social injustice in college athletics by wearing patches dedicated to Jack Trice.
- Jack Trice, who was Iowa State's first black student-athlete, died tragically from injuries suffered in his second football game in 1923.
- The patch design is similar to the jersey Trice wore during his time at Iowa State.

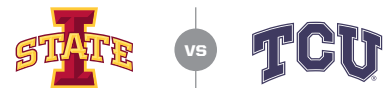
