## KANSAS WELCOMES RED RAIDERS TO ALLEN FIELDHOUSE

The Jayhawks continue its Texas swing by hosting Texas Tech (6-8, 0-3 Big 12) on Saturday, Jan. 11, at 7 p.m. inside Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks (7-8, 0-3 Big 12) have won two of the last four games against the Red Raiders (6-8, 0-3 Big 12) while the two teams meet for the 22nd time in KU history. The game will be broadcast live on the Jayhawk Television Network/ESPN3 and Jayhawk Radio Network.

## KANSAS FAST BREAKS

- KU has won two of the last four contests against Texas Tech and is 3-7 against the Red Raiders when playing inside Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks swept the 2011-12 series with victories in Lawrence and Lubbock.
- Defensively, Kansas has held six opponents to under 37 percent shooting from the field, which includes two of the last three games. KU has held eight opponents to under 40 percent shooting in 2013-14.
- The Jayhawks have outrebounded 10-of-14 opponents this season, including six of the last eight games. Kansas' largest rebound margin was 16 in the season opener against Oral Roberts.
- Kansas shot a season-best 53.3 percent from beyond the arc at TCU (1/8) making 8-of-15 against the Horned Frogs. The Jayhawks made a season-high 12 three-pointers against Texas Southern (12/12).
- KU has a record of 119-53 (.704) in Allen Fieldhouse under Henrickson and an all-time home record of 396-153 (.723).
- Kansas' all-time Big 12 record is 108-171, while KU is 51-100 in conference play under Henrickson.
- In Big 12 action, senior CeCe Harper is averaging 3.0 steals per game. She is also averaging 8.6 assists per game in the last five games. On the season, she is averaging 5.5 assists per game after dishing out 82 in 2013-14.
- Junior forward Chelsea Gardner is averaging three blocks per game in conference play. She had two blocks at TCU which moved her into 10th place on Kansas' all-time blocks list. She has 26 on the year and 91 in her career.
- Guard Natalie Knight couldn't be stopped from behind the arc at TCU. The junior made 6-of-7 (.857) from the three-point line. The six three-pointers was a career-high for Knight, who surpassed her previous career-best of five against Iowa State in 2013.
- Senior Markisha Hawkins is making the most of her minutes off the bench. The guard scored a career-high 16 points against CMU (11/28) and recently grabbed a career-best six rebounds at TCU (1/8). She is averaging 4.9 points and 1.6 rebounds per game.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

Junior guard Natalie Knight led the Jayhawks with a season-high 20 points at TCU behind 6-of-7 (.857) shooting from beyond the arc. Knight is averaging 9.1 points per game after starting every contest. Junior forward Chelsea Gardner recorded two blocks against TCU to move into 10th all-time on Kansas' block list. She has 26 blocks on the season and is scoring a team-high 15.9 points per game.

Senior guard CeCe Harper is averaging 8.6 assists in the last five games and three steals per game in Big 12 action. On the year, she is averaging 5.5 assists per game and has a total of 82 while averaging 9.4 points per game. Junior guard Asia Boyd is averaging 12.8 points per game in 11 starts. She is also averaging 5.3 boards per contest. Freshman Jada Brown started for the second-consecutive game and is averaging 3.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game since being inserted into the starting lineup.

Freshman guard Dakota Gonzalez continues to be one of the first Jayhawks head coach Bonnie Henrickson calls upon from the bench. She is averaging 4.2 points and 1.8 rebounds per game. She has appeared in 13-of-15 KU contests in 2013-14 and is playing 14.8 minutes per game. Senior guard Markisha Hawkins came off the bench and scored 12 points on the road at TCU. She also grabbed a career-high six rebounds. Hawkins is averaging 4.9 points and 15.2 minutes per game.

Freshman forward Caelynn Manning-Allen collected her first career start in the final game of 2013 against Yale. She is averaging 1.3 points and 2.2 rebounds per game. Junior forward Bunny Williams has also appeared in every game and started eight this season. She is averaging 2.0 boards in 14.5 minutes per game. Sophomore guard Lamaria Cole is averaging 13.0 minutes per game in 12 appearances. She has 19 assists and 12 steals on the year and is averaging 3.8 points per game. Freshman guard Dylan Gonzalez is averaging 1.3 points and 3.0 minutes per game in six appearances.

KANSAS VS. TEXAS TECH: THE SERIES

The Red Raiders lead the overall series 16-5 and have won the last two contests. Kansas won both games during the 2011-12 season, which snapped TTU's 12-game winning streak. The Jayhawks opened the series with a 76-53 win over Texas Tech in Lubbock on Dec. 2, 1978.

THE LAST TIME OUT

Kansas last faced Texas Tech on Feb. 24, 2013 and the Red Raiders edged KU 72-70 in the final seconds of the game. Kansas overcame a 16-point first-half deficit, but Texas Tech's Christine Hyde drove the lane in the final four seconds to fend off the Jayhawk comeback and claim the victory. Angel Goodrich led KU with 23 points, her sixth 20-plus point effort of the season.

SCOUTING THE RED RAIDERS

Texas Tech is two games under .500 with an overall mark of 6-8 on the season and is 0-3 in Big 12 action. The Red Raiders have lost four-straight games heading into Saturday's contest. Junior guard Amber Battle leads TTU with 17.4 points per game, which is fourth among the conference standings. She also leads the team with 8.6 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game. Defensively, senior center Haley Schneider leads the team with 1.7 blocks per game. The Red Raiders average 62.1 points per game and are shooting 38.3 percent from the field. On the defensive side, Texas Tech is averaging 7.1 steals and 3.8 blocks per game.

TCU LEFTOVERS

- Junior Natalie Knight led the Jayhawks against TCU with a season-high 20 points behind 6-of-7 (.857) shooting from behind the arc. Knight's six treys marks a career-best surpassing her previous career-high of five, which she set vs. Iowa State on Jan. 30, 2013 and is the most by a Jayhawk since Danielle McCray recorded six against Baylor in 2009.
- The 52-50 loss to TCU was KU's second overall to the Horned Frogs and snapped Kansas' three-game winning streak.
- Kansas held TCU to 15 first-half points, the lowest surrendered by the Jayhawks in the first period this season, and 52 on the night, which is the lowest offensive output by an opponent in 2013-14. KU also held the Horned Frogs to 36.5 percent shooting for the contest.
- Junior Chelsea Gardner blocked two shots in the second half to bring her career total to 91 and place her 10th all-time on the Kansas block list.

THIS DAY IN KANSAS WOMEN’S BASKETBALL HISTORY

The Jayhawks were victorious against Big 12 foe Iowa State on Jan. 11, 1983. Kansas defeated the Cyclones 84-71 on the road. Angie Snider and Angela Taylor combined for 52 points leading KU to victory in Ames. The Jayhawks recorded 15 steals and shot 54.0 percent. Kansas is 3-4 all-time when playing on the 11th day of January and the last time KU played on Jan. 11 was in 2012.

A LONE STAR STATE OF MIND

After opening Big 12 play at home against West Virginia, the Jayhawks are set to play five-straight games against opponents from Texas. Three of those five games, Kansas travels to the Lone Star state, which is home to Chelsea Gardner, CeCe Harper, Lamaria Cole and Bunny Williams. KU opens and closes the Texas swing with No. 7 Baylor. In that span, Kansas travels to Baylor, TCU and Texas, while hosting Texas Tech and Baylor.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN

Kansas is among the top five in several Big 12 statistical categories in 2013-14. The Jayhawks are fourth in the conference in blocked shots with 4.7 per game and fifth in steals per game with 8.2. KU has the fifth-best free throw percentage in the Big 12 at 71.5 percent. The Jayhawks also recorded the most free throw attempts in a single game with 54 against Oral Roberts (11/10) and shot the second-highest field goal percentage at 61.4 percent against Creighton on Nov. 17.

Individually, junior forward Chelsea Gardner is first in the league with four double-doubles on the season. Gardner ranks sixth in the conference standings in scoring (15.9 ppg) and third in field goal percentage (.601). She is second in defensive rebounds with 6.0 per game. Junior guard Natalie Knight has the third-best assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.5. Senior guard CeCe Harper has 82 assists on the year for 5.5 per game which is fifth among the Big 12. She is also third in the conference standings in steals per game with 2.2. Junior guard Asia Boyd is 15th in scoring in the Big 12 with 12.8 points per game.

CHELSEA LATELY

Junior forward Chelsea Gardner has stepped up to the challenge of filling the scoring void left by graduating three 1,000 point scorers at the conclusion of the 2012-13 season. Gardner has scored in double figures in 12-of-15 games this season and is averaging 15.9 points per game. On the season, she is shooting 60.1 percent from the field, which is the third-best field goal percentage in the Big 12. She scored a career-high 30 points against Texas Southern on Dec. 12. Gardner has recorded four double-doubles this year and 10 in her career. She has 671 career points and is on pace to reach 1,000 points by the end of her Jayhawk career.

A KNIGHT’S TALE

Junior Natalie Knight made her return to the hardwood on Oct. 30 in an exhibition contest against Pittsburg State after suffering a season-ending knee injury in 2012-13. The Olathe, Kan. native picked up where she left by being the most consistent Jayhawk on the court and among one of the top ball-handlers in the Big 12. Knight has the third-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the conference at 2.5. She is averaging a team-high 33.2 minutes per game and has turned the ball over just 18 times in 15 appearances. Knight is scoring 9.1 points per game and recorded double-digit points in eight games. She scored a season-high 20 points behind a career-best six three-pointers on the road against TCU on Jan. 8.

CECE AND THE ASSIST FACTORY

In 2013-14, the Jayhawks’ offense runs through senior guard CeCe Harper and her assists per game average continues to rise with each game. It only took 13 games this season for Harper to surpass her 2012-13 mark of 62 assists. She has recorded 82 this season, is averaging 5.5 assists per game and dished out a career-high 13 against Tulsa on Dec. 22. Prior to 2013-14, she averaged 1.4 assists per game and totaled 115 assists in three years. Harper has recorded two double-digit assist efforts this season and ranks fifth among the Big 12 in assists per game (5.5).

GARDNER’S BLOCK PARTY

Junior forward Chelsea Gardner leads the Jayhawks with 26 blocks on the season and has 91 in her career. With two blocks against TCU, Gardner moved into 10th all-time on Kansas’ block list. Three blocks against Texas Tech would move Gardner into a ninth place. Lisa Tate is the all-time block leader with 269 from 1991-94. Gardner is averaging 1.7 blocks per game which is fourth in the Big 12.

## KANSAS' BENCH MARKS THE SPOT

The Jayhawks' bench has added an extra spark this season averaging 18.5 points per game and scored a season-high 30 points against Yale on Dec. 29. KU's bench has scored in double figures in 13-of-15 games and reached the 20-point mark in seven games. Chelsea Gardner came off the bench and scored 26 against Yale, which is the most points off the bench for a Jayhawk in 2013-14. Seniors CeCe Harper and Markisha Hawkins came off the bench and have led the team in scoring on two different occasions. Harper delivered 17 points on the road against Minnesota (11/20), while Hawkins scored 16 against CMU. Freshman Keyla Morgan recorded a career-best 11 points off the bench against No. 2 Duke. While fellow rookie Dakota Gonzalez knocked in a career-best 18 points off the bench against Texas Southern (12/12).

## THAT 70's SHOW

Kansas' success during the Bonnie Henrickson-era has been pretty much based on 70 points. When the Jayhawks score 70 or more points, Kansas owns a 109-13 record (.888) during her tenure. When KU opponents score less than 70 points, the Jayhawks are 139-70 (.662) during that span.

## SHARP SHOOTING JAYHAWKS

Kansas has shot 50 percent or better in three of its last six games and a total of six times this season. The Jayhawks shot a season-best 61.4 percent (27-44) against Creighton on Nov. 17. It marked the highest field goal percentage since KU's opening round of the WNIT against Wichita State in 2011. Individually, junior Chelsea Gardner has shot 70 percent or better in six of Kansas' 15 games and shot a season-high of 85.7 percent (6-7) against Xavier on Nov. 29.

## JAYHAWKS FACE TOURNAMENT TESTED OPPONENTS

In 2013-14, Kansas faces 12 opponents that advanced to the NCAA Tournament, five regular season league champions, five WNIT squads and 11 teams coming off 20-win campaigns. Texas Tech (Jan. 11) is the next opponent KU faces that earned a berth to the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Kansas is set to play 19 games in the comfort of Allen Fieldhouse in 2013-14, eight of which came during the non-conference slate. KU is off to a 6-3 start in Allen Fieldhouse in 2013-14. Last season, the Jayhawks were 13-4 at home. KU has a record of 119-52 (.704) in Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bonnie Henrickson and an all-time home record of 395-153 (.723).

## KU VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

So far this season, six of Kansas' opponents are ranked in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and *USA Today* Top 25 Poll. No. 2 Duke was the first and highest ranked opponent the Jayhawks will face in 2013-14. KU is 0-3 against opponents ranked in the polls. Last season, KU played 11 teams ranked in the Top 25 polls and had an overall record of 4-7 against ranked opponents.

## OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Juniors Natalie Knight and Bunny Williams were voted captains by their team prior to the start of the 2013-14 season. It is the first time either has been voted the honor of captain for the Jayhawks.

## NOT IN OUR LEAGUE

The Jayhawks boast a 331-153 (.686) record all-time versus non-conference opponents. The Jayhawks' best non-conference record came during the 2005-06 season when they posted a perfect 11-0 mark during the regular season. KU is 72-16 (.862) in non-conference games since the 2007-08 season.

## JAYHAWKS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

Kansas is among one of the most televised women's basketball programs in the country. The Jayhawks will have three games featured on FOX Sports Network, while every home game will air on the new Jayhawk Television Network/ESPN3. KU is slated to play 32 contests in 2013-14 including exhibition games and 28 of those games will be televised.

## HAWK TALK WITH BONNIE HENRICKSON

Women's basketball Hawk Talk got an early start to the season with its first show on Thursday, Oct. 24. The show is hosted by Nate Bukaty and airs most Thursdays starting at 6 p.m., throughout the season at Henry T's. The remaining Hawk Talk dates are: Jan. 16, Jan. 23, Jan. 30, Feb. 6, Feb. 13, Feb. 20, Feb. 27. All shows can be heard on the Jayhawk Radio Network and can be seen tape delayed on the Jayhawk Television Network.

## KU PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH IN BIG 12

Kansas women's basketball was selected to finish seventh in 2013-14 by the Big 12 coaches as released by the conference. Oklahoma was named the preseason favorite by the league coaches, an honor that the Sooners have claimed four times, tallying five first-place votes. Baylor, who won the previous three Big 12 titles, was picked to finish second with three first-place votes.

## HOW SWEET IT IS

Kansas women's basketball advanced to back-to-back NCAA Sweet 16's for the first time in program history in 2012 and 2013. KU is one of nine women's programs in the country to play in the round of 16 in the past two seasons. The Jayhawks are also one of two Big 12 schools to advance to the last two Sweet 16's. The Baylor Bears have also appeared in the last two Sweet 16 rounds. Kansas has appeared in seven of the last nine postseasons under head coach Bonnie Henrickson.

## HARD TO SAY GOODBYE

The end of the 2012-13 season marked the conclusion of three careers that made an impact on the Kansas women's basketball program. Angel Goodrich, Monica Engelman and Carolyn Davis helped guide the Jayhawks to back-to-back NCAA Sweet 16 appearances and all finished their careers in the 1,000 point scorer club. Goodrich became KU's all-time assist leader during her final season after collecting 771 in four seasons. She was drafted by the Tulsa Shock as the 29th overall pick in the WNBA Draft. Davis became the seventh player in Kansas history to score 1,700 points and grab 700 rebounds in a career.

HEAD COACH BONNIE HENRICKSON



The old adage ‘Hard work pays off’ has never rung more true than when following the career of Kansas women’s basketball head coach Bonnie Henrickson. In nine years, Henrickson has molded the proud Jayhawk program back into a perennial contender.

Despite Kansas being a program rich with history and tradition, Henrickson accepted the task of taking over a team coming off its fourth-consecutive losing season when she arrived in Lawrence in 2004. She immediately rolled up her sleeves and went to work and has transformed the Jayhawks into a team to be reckoned with once again.

In her nine years at the helm of the Kansas program, Henrickson has taken the Jayhawk program from the cellar of the Big 12 Conference to continually climbing toward the

top of the league standings. In addition, KU has advanced to postseason play in seven of her nine seasons, including each of the last six years, highlighted by back-to-back NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 runs.

In each of the past two seasons, Henrickson led the Jayhawks to NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. Kansas advanced to the 2012-13 round of 16 after defeating nationally-ranked Colorado and South Carolina in tough opening-round games. KU concluded the season with a 20-14 record, its third season in a row with 20 or more wins, and a spot in the in the top-25 *USA Today* Coaches Poll. Senior Angel Goodrich earned WBCA All-America honorable mention and First Team All-Big 12 accolades. Fellow senior Carolyn Davis earned Second Team All-Big 12 honors. Davis, Goodrich and Monica Engelman each ended their careers as 1,000-point scorers. Goodrich was drafted by the Tulsa Shock as the 29th overall pick in the 2013 WNBA Draft.

With the best postseason effort by the Jayhawks since 1998, Henrickson guided Kansas to a 21-13 record during the 2011-12 season and NCAA Tournament victories over Nebraska (57-49) and Delaware (70-64), before falling to Tennessee in the Sweet 16. All-America honorable mention, All-Big 12 Second Team selection and the nation’s assist leader, Goodrich led the way for the Jayhawks during the NCAA Tournament. KU also had All-America honorable mention and All-Big 12 First Team honoree Davis for the first 23 games, before a knee injury sidelined her for the remainder of the season.

With more than just putting wins back on the record, Henrickson has produced a program Jayhawk fans have come to embrace. A Big 12 single-game attendance record was set when Kansas hosted South Florida in the 2009 WNIT Championship game, as 16,113 fans supported the KU women’s basketball program in historic Allen Fieldhouse. KU finished the 2008-09 season ranked in the Top 25 on the NCAA attendance chart and ranked fourth in the country in attendance increase.

Henrickson and her staff have not only guided their athletes to victories on the court, but many have achieved tremendous accomplishments in the classroom at KU. Under Henrickson, the overall team GPA has steadily risen since she arrived in Lawrence and

during the 2007-08 school year the Jayhawks achieved a team-record 3.11 GPA. In her nine seasons, the Jayhawks have earned 29 Academic All-Big 12 Team appointments.

Henrickson arrived at KU after establishing herself as one of the nation’s brightest young coaches at Virginia Tech, where she was head coach for seven seasons and guided the Hokies to a record of 158-62 and seven postseason appearances. Under her leadership, Virginia Tech reached the NCAA tournament five times, the WNIT twice and won 20 or more games every season.

In July 2000, she was the head coach of the gold-medal winning women’s USA Basketball team that traveled to Taiwan for the R. William Jones Cup competition. This appointment marked her second stint with a USA Basketball team; she also served as an assistant coach on the Team USA squad which won the silver medal at the 1999 World University Games.

Henrickson, a Willmar, Minn., native, graduated from St. Cloud State University in 1986. As a player, she helped SCSU win three Northern Sun Conference championships and advance to three NCAA Division II quarterfinals.

In her four years as a player, SCSU compiled a 97-25 overall record, including a 31-4 mark in her sophomore season. She still ranks among the school leaders in points (4th - 1,731), rebounds (3rd - 995), free throws (1st - 507) and free throw percentage (4th - .790). She also was named to the all-conference team three times. Henrickson served as team captain her junior and senior years.

She earned her master’s degree in physical education in 1988 from Western Illinois University while serving as a graduate assistant coach with the women’s basketball team.
