BAM! POW! SMASH! JAYHAWKS RIDE HIGH INTO SUPERHERO DAY AGAINST WVU

The Super Jayhawks fly back into Allen Fieldhouse for an action-packed Superhero Day on Saturday, Jan. 24 against West Virginia. The contest is slated for a 1 p.m., tipoff on FOX Sports Network and the Jayhawk Radio Network. Saturday afternoon Allen Fieldhouse will be transformed into headquarters for Superheroes of all ages. Children who dress up as their favorite superhero will receive free admission to the game and will be able to participate in a superhero parade.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

Kansas snapped its Big 12 Conference losing skid after overcoming a 17-point deficit to edge Texas Tech, 68-66, on Wednesday evening. The Jayhawks look to keep the momentum rolling with another victory on Saturday afternoon. KU has a 9-4 mark in the friendly confines of Allen Fieldhouse this season and a win this weekend would mark the 10th victory at home in 2014-15.

Senior forward Chelsea Gardner is averaging a team-high 15.9 points per game, the fourth-best average in the league, while shooting 55.1 percent from the field. Senior guard Natalie Knight has stayed consistent for the Jayhawks connecting on 40.6 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. She is second on the team with 12.6 and 5.6 rebounds per game. Both Gardner and Knight have scored in double figures in all but three games this year.

Freshmen guards Lauren Aldridge and Chayla Cheadle are making an early impact in KU's lineup and are averaging 7.5 and 6.8 points, respectively. Aldridge has started every game this season at point and is fifth in the conference in assists per game with 4.3 and has played the most minutes (620) among the Jayhawks in 2014-15. Cheadle led the squad with 15 points at Kansas State (1/11) and is connecting on 36 percent of her shots from long range. Sophomore forward Jada Brown is the final member of Kansas' starting lineup. The Las Vegas, Nevada native is grabbing 3.2 rebounds per contest, which is fourth-best on the team. She is also averaging 2.1 points per game in 19 starts.

The Jayhawks are averaging 64.3 points per game with a +3.7 scoring margin over their opponents. KU is shooting 43.9 percent from the field, while holding its opponents to shooting 37 percent. Kansas has connected on 37.1 percent of its attempts from the three-point line, which is the second-best mark in the Big 12. The Jayhawks are averaging 36.5 rebounds, 14.4 assists, 5.9 steals and 4.1 blocks per game.

KANSAS FAST BREAKS

- Three or more Jayhawks have netted double-figure scoring performances in 13 of Kansas' 19 games this season. KU had four reach double-digit scoring in three-straight games and in a total of seven contests. Senior forward Chelsea Gardner has scored 10 or more points in 16-of-19 games in 2014-15, while senior Natalie Knight has also contributed double figures in 16 of the Jayhawks' 19 games this year.
- For the first time in nearly 14 years, the Jayhawks shot 67 percent from three-point range on a minimum of 10 attempts against Incarnate Word (12/4), connecting on 8-of-12 shots from beyond the arc. It marked the highest completion rate from three since Dec. 2, 2000, when Kansas went 8-for-11 (72.7 percent) against St. Joseph in Allen Fieldhouse. KU followed that with a 7-for-11 effort from the three-point line against then-No. 10 Cal (12/7).
- KU has limited its opponents to 37.0 percent shooting from the field. The Jayhawks have held three opponents to less than 30 percent shooting, including holding the Cal Golden Bears to 25 percent from the field. Cal averaged 90 points coming into the match-up and KU kept the Bears under 40 points.
- Kansas' all-time record is 780-559 while the program has an all-time conference record of 238-254. Head coach Bonnie Henrickson is 339-225 all-time and 181-163 at KU.
- Gardner, a Preseason All-Big 12 selection, joined the 1,000-point club after scoring 24 points in the season opener against South Dakota (11/16). Knight has 930 career points and needs 70 more to join Gardner in the 1,000-point club, which she is on pace to reach by the end of February. It would mark the first time since 2012-13 that multiple Jayhawks have reached the 1,000-point milestone in the same season.
- Gardner has attempted more than 10 shots 39 times in her four-year career and with her 10-for-13 performance against TCU (1/14), Gardner averages an astounding 52 percent conversion rate in games she has attempted more than 10 shots.
- Rookie Lauren Aldridge is one of two freshmen in the Big 12 conference starting at the point guard position. The Marshfield, Missouri native is fifth in the league in assists per game with 4.3 and is in the top 10 in the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (seventh, 1.5).

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS

West Virginia heads into the contest with a 12-6 mark and a 2-4 record in Big 12 Conference play. The Mountaineers are looking to extend their two-game win streak, after back-to-back victories against Oklahoma State (1/17) and Kansas State (1/21). Before conference action, WVU had a 10-2 record that included a seven-game win streak. West Virginia was selected to finish third in the Big 12 by league coaches.

Junior guard Bria Holmes leads the way with 20.4 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. Senior forward Avereé Fields follows with 15.0 points and pulls down an average of 6.7 rebounds per game. Junior guard Jessica Morton is the third and final Mountaineer averaging double figures with 10.3 points per game. The Augusta, Georgia native led the Mountaineers in scoring against K-State with 22 points. Redshirt sophomore center Lanay Montgomery chalks up the most boards with 8.2 rebounds per game.

Collectively, West Virginia averages 70.1 points per game behind a +11.8 scoring margin over its opponents and is shooting 42 percent from the field. The Mountaineers average 45.4 rebounds, 14.2 assists and 7.2 blocks per game.

AND THE AWARD GOES TO...

Freshman guard Lauren Aldridge was the first Jayhawk to earn Big 12 weekly honors in 2014-15. She was named Big 12 Freshman of the Week for the week of Dec. 8 after helping KU to a pair of victories. Kansas swept the weekly accolades for the week of Dec. 29 after Natalie Knight earned player of the week honors and Terriell Bradley was named the freshman of the week. It's the first weekly honor for Bradley and second of Knight's career.

GARDNER ADDS TO LIST OF ACCOLADES

After ending 2013-14 with various postseason awards, Kansas senior forward Chelsea Gardner kicked off the current season the same way, adding to her list of accolades. The DeSoto, Texas, native was named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team as voted on by the conference head coaches. The 6-3 forward was also named to the Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List on Dec. 10, one of five players in the Big 12 to be named to the watch list.

SUPER SENIORS!

Seniors Asia Boyd, Chelsea Gardner, Natalie Knight and Bunny Williams will not only lead the Jayhawks as captains, but will also be a strong force for Kansas during the season on the court. During 2013-14, the four seniors accounted for almost 60 percent of Kansas' 2,134 total points (1,273). Leading the pack was Gardner, who tallied a team-high 548 points throughout the season. The captains were also successful behind the arc tallying 96 three-point shots. Knight knocked down 63 of these, which was the fourth-highest in program history. To add to this success, they chalked up 563 total rebounds and Gardner led again with 270 rebounds. During the seniors' tenure at Kansas, the Jayhawks made back-to-back NCAA Sweet 16's in 2012 and 2013.

A KNIGHT'S TALE

Senior Natalie Knight has had a consistent presence on the hardwood for the Jayhawks since she first stepped on to the court as a freshman in 2011. Knight made her 100th career start in the Crimson and Blue on Jan. 14 against TCU. She has started every game played since she arrived in Lawrence except the final 15 games of the 2012-13 season when she suffered a knee injury. The Olathe, Kansas native has played 3,317 minutes in her career and averages 32.4 minutes per game in 2014-15. During her senior season, Knight is averaging 12.6 points and 5.6 rebounds. She has shot 50 percent or better from the three-point line in nine of KU's 19 contests. She recorded her first double-double with 13 points and a career-best 15 rebounds against Arkansas State (12/14).

CHELSEA LATELY

Senior forward Chelsea Gardner opened the 2014-15 season with her 50th double-digit scoring effort and her 21st double-figure rebounding performance with 24 points and 11 rebounds on Nov. 16 against South Dakota. She converted six of her nine shots in the 2014-15 season opener for a 64.3 shooting percentage from the field. Gardner has 22 double-doubles in her career and four on the year, which is fourth in the league. In her senior campaign, Gardner is averaging 15.9 points, the fourth-best scoring average in the Big 12, and 7.2 rebounds per game, which is the sixth-best mark in the league. She is also shooting 55.1 percent from the field, which is good for fifth among the Big 12 players.

THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS

Kansas added four freshmen to the 2014-15 roster during the offseason and several are making an impact for the Jayhawks. Lauren Aldridge has started all 19 games at point guard and is fourth on the team in scoring with 7.5 points per game. She played two games in a row without a turnover while dishing out 13 assists. Aldridge has scored in double figures seven times, including a season-high 14 against No. 3 Baylor (1/17). Chayla Cheadle is fifth on the team with 6.8 points per game and scored a career-high 19 points against Arkansas State (12/14), 16 of those coming in the final 20 minutes of play. Terriell Bradley came off the bench against Creighton (12/22) to net a career-high 21 points. She also recorded the second-best single-game three-point percentage after a perfect 5-for-5 from behind the arc against Iona (11/26).

SERIES BREAKDOWN

Record

Heading into Saturday's match up, the all-time series between the Jayhawks and Mountaineers is tied, 3-3. Kansas leads the series in Lawrence, 2-1.

Overview

When the two teams will meet for the seventh time, KU looks to snap its three-contest losing streak against WVU.

Last Time Out

Kansas dropped its final regular-season game of the 2013-14 season in Morgantown to the Mountaineers, 67-60. CeCe Harper led all scorers and tied her season-high with 19 points. Harper also dished out seven assists and tied her career-high with three blocked shots. On the defensive end, Kansas held West Virginia scoreless for nearly seven minutes in the first half from the 10:08 mark until the 3:17 mark.

1,000 REASONS TO CELEBRATE

On Sunday, Nov. 16, Chelsea Gardner became the 27th Jayhawk, and 10th under head coach Bonnie Henrickson, to score over 1,000 career points in Kansas women's basketball history. Her 24-point effort against South Dakota pushed her over the 1,000 career point mark. The senior forward is the fourth Jayhawk in as many seasons to score over 1,000 career points. She is the third Jayhawk to reach the milestone wearing the No. 15 jersey and the fifth to hail from the Lone Star state. Gardner is also the 15th forward to score to join the 1,000-point club and the second standing at 6-3.

JAYHAWKS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Kansas' match-up with Notre Dame was the first time this season that KU faced a ranked opponent. It was also the first time that the Jayhawks squared off with the No. 1 team in the nation since 2012-13 when Kansas hosted Baylor in Allen Fieldhouse. The last time KU defeated a nationally-ranked foe was against Cal, 62-39, Sunday (12/7). KU is 1-2 against nationally ranked opponents this season. Since 2004, KU is 14-64 against opponents in the national polls and 4-29 against foes ranked in the top 10. KU has defeated at least one top 10 foe in the past two seasons and taken down a ranked opponent at least once the last four seasons.

DEFENSIVELY SOUND

Head coach Bonnie Henrickson stresses the importance of defense and the Jayhawks are taking that to heart in 2014-15. On the season, Kansas has held its opponents to 37 percent shooting. The Jayhawks have held three opponents to under 30 percent shooting including then-No. 10 Cal, who has one of the most potent offenses in the country. The Golden Bears were averaging 90 points coming into the match-up and Kansas' defense held Cal to 39 points and 24 percent shooting from the field. On the season, Kansas has held six opponents under 50 points.

THAT 70'S SHOW

Kansas' success during the Bonnie Henrickson-era has been pretty much based on 70 points. When the Jayhawks score 70 or more points, Kansas owns a 114-19 record (.869) during her tenure. When KU opponents score less than 70 points, the Jayhawks are 145-74 (.665) during that span.

THREE'S COMPANY

Senior guard Natalie Knight was among the top-10 three-point shooters in the Big 12 during the 2013-14 season. Last year, she shot 40.9 percent from beyond the arc, which was the best percentage in the league. In 2014-15, Knight is shooting 40.6 percent from the three-point line, which is once again one of the top percentages in the conference (fifth). She has shot 50 percent or higher from behind the arc in nine of KU's 19 contests, including a season-high 74 percent (3-of-4) against then-No. 1 Notre Dame (11/30), then-No. 10 Cal (12/7) and Incarnate Word (12/4). In her career, Knight is shooting 38.9 percent, which is currently the second-best three-point average in KU women's basketball history.

For the first time in nearly 14 years, the Jayhawks shot 67 percent from three-point range on a minimum of 10 attempts against Incarnate Word (12/4), connecting on 8-of-12 shots from beyond the arc. It marked the highest completion rate from three since Dec. 2, 2000, when Kansas went 8-for-11 (72.7 percent) against St. Joseph in Allen Fieldhouse.

JAYHAWKS FACE TOURNAMENT TESTED OPPONENTS

Kansas faces 14 opponents that advanced to the postseason last season, which is two more than the previous season. KU's non-conference schedule included three conference champions and seven squads that reached the 20-win plateau. Kansas has a 4-7 record after facing 11 programs that appeared in the 2014 postseason.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN

After 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign, Kansas has several players among the top of Big 12 statistical categories. Senior Chelsea Gardner is fourth in the league in scoring (15.9), sixth in rebounds (7.2) and fifth in field goal percentage (55.1). Gardner is also third in the Big 12 in blocks per game (2.0). Senior Natalie Knight is fifth in the conference in three-point field goal percentage (40.6). Freshman Lauren Aldridge is No. 5 in assists per game (4.3). Knight is right behind tied for sixth with 4.0 assists per game. The Jayhawks are second in the league in three-point percentage (37.1).

HOW THE JAYHAWKS STACK UP NATIONALLY

Kansas also stacks up well with the rest of the country and is represented in the top half of several categories in 2014-15 as of Jan. 15. The Jayhawks are currently ranked 70th in the country in field-goal defense after limiting opponents to 37 percent shooting. Offensively, KU is 19th in three-point field goal percentage (37.1). Senior forward Chelsea Gardner ranks 24th in the country with a field goal percentage of 55.1, while senior guard Natalie Knight is 38th in three-point field goal percentage (40.6).

A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

The Jayhawks' bench is providing a spark offensively in 2014-15 and is averaging 19.8 points per game. Senior Asia Boyd is one of the first players head coach Bonnie Henrickson calls upon off the bench and she is the Jayhawks' third-leading scorer with 9.0 points per game.

Christopher is a two-time All-Metro League selection, who averaged six points and nine assists last season for Cleveland High School. Johnson helped the Leavenworth High School to a Kansas 5A state title last season. She averaged 15.1 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.7 blocks per game. Another local product, Kopatich prepped at the same high school (Olathe South) that produced current Jayhawk Natalie Knight. She averaged 12.2 points, 6.3 assists and 3.1 steals per game as a junior. A two-time all-league selection, Robertson helped Bishop O'Dowd High School to a California Division III state title and an open division state title.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Kansas is set to play 19 games in the comfort of Allen Fieldhouse in 2014-15, 12 of which come during the non-conference slate. KU is off to a 9-4 start at home this season, while the Jayhawks compiled a 9-8 mark in Allen Fieldhouse in 2013-14. KU has a record of 130-62 (.686) in Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bonnie Henrickson and an all-time home record of 404-163 (.715).

ALLEN FIELDHOUSE HISTORY

Named in honor the late Dr. F.C. "Phog" Allen, the Jayhawks' head coach for 39 years, Allen Fieldhouse is labeled by many as one of the best places in America to watch a college basketball game. This astounding basketball monument has been home to Jayhawk basketball for 60 years, including the inaugural year of KU women's basketball (1969). In this building, Jayhawk greats such as Lynette Woodard, Tamecka Dixon, Angela Aycock and many more had record-breaking performances for Kansas. Woodard achieved the most single-game points and rebounds and Angel Goodrich accomplished the most single-game assists, just to name a few. Since 2006, the Jayhawks have overcome eight ranked opponents inside their home arena, including the 76-60 win over then-No. 7 Baylor during the 2013-14 season when Kansas snapped the Lady Bears' 53-game conference win streak. Not only are the player accomplishments inside Allen Fieldhouse well-known, but so are the fans that pack the bleachers. In 2009, the Jayhawk faithful set a Big-12 single-game record of attendance with 16,113 fans in attendance for the WNIT title game of Kansas versus South Florida inside "The Phog."

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Seniors Asia Boyd, Chelsea Gardner, Natalie Knight and Bunny Williams were selected as captains prior to the start of the 2014-15 season. KANSAS TABBED TO FINISH EIGHTH IN BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

Kansas was voted to finish the 2014-15 conference slate in eighth place by the Big 12 coaches. Texas took the top of honor of being named the 2014-15 preseason front-runner, which hasn't happened since 2004-05, with five first-place votes. 2013-14 Co-Big 12 Champions Baylor and West Virginia were voted in second and third place, respectively, with two first-place votes each. Oklahoma State was selected fourth and received one first-place vote. Oklahoma was next at No. 5, followed by Iowa State in sixth place. TCU, Kansas, Kansas State and Texas Tech rounded out the poll.

In remembrance of Van Dyke, who passed away earlier this fall after battling Leukemia, the Jayhawks will wear special patches that say "Whitney". HEAD COACH BONNIE HENRICKSON



The old adage 'Hard work pays off' has never rung more true than when following the career of Kansas women's basketball head coach Bonnie Henrickson. In nine years, Henrickson has molded the proud Jayhawk program back into a perennial contender.

Despite Kansas being a program rich with history and tradition, Henrickson accepted the task of taking over a team coming off its fourth-consecutive losing season when she arrived in Lawrence in 2004. She immediately rolled up her sleeves and went to work and has transformed the Jayhawks into a team to be reckoned with once again.

In her 10 years at the helm of the Kansas program, Henrickson has taken the Jayhawk program from the cellar of the Big 12 Conference to continually climbing toward the top of the league standings. In addition, KU has advanced to postseason play in seven of her 10 seasons, including six-straight years from 2008-13, highlighted by back-to-back NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 runs in 2012 and 2013.

After losing three 1,000 point scorers to graduation, Henrickson led a young group of Jayhawks to an upset of No. 7 Baylor, 76-60, to snap the Lady Bears' 53-game Big 12 Conference win streak to highlight the 2013-14 season.

Prior to the 2013-14 season, Henrickson led the Jayhawks to consecutive NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. Kansas advanced to the 2012-13 round of 16 after defeating nationally-ranked Colorado and South Carolina in tough opening-round games. KU concluded the season with a 20-14 record, its third season in a row with 20 or more wins, and a spot in the in the top-25 *USA Today* Coaches Poll. Senior Angel Goodrich earned WBCA All-America honorable mention and First Team All-Big 12 accolades. Fellow senior Carolyn Davis earned Second Team All-Big 12 honors. Davis, Goodrich and Monica Engelman each ended their careers as 1,000-point scorers. Goodrich was drafted by the Tulsa Shock as the 29th overall pick in the 2013 WNBA Draft.

With the best postseason effort by the Jayhawks since 1998, Henrickson guided Kansas to a 21-13 record during the 2011-12 season and NCAA Tournament victories over Nebraska (57-49) and Delaware (70-64), before falling to Tennessee in the Sweet 16. All-America honorable mention, All-Big 12 Second Team selection and the nation's assist leader, Goodrich led the way for the Jayhawks during the NCAA Tournament. KU also had All-America honorable mention and All-Big 12 First Team honoree Davis for the first 23 games, before a knee injury sidelined her for the remainder of the season.

With more than just putting wins back on the record, Henrickson has produced a program Jayhawk fans have come to embrace. A Big 12 single-game attendance record was set when Kansas hosted South Florida in the 2009 WNIT Championship game, as 16,113 fans supported the KU women's basketball program in historic Allen Fieldhouse. KU finished the

2008-09 season ranked in the Top 25 on the NCAA attendance chart and ranked fourth in the country in attendance increase.

Henrickson and her staff have not only guided their athletes to victories on the court, but many have achieved tremendous accomplishments in the classroom at KU. Under Henrickson, the overall team GPA has steadily risen since she arrived in Lawrence and during the 2007-08 school year the Jayhawks achieved a team-record 3.11 GPA. In her nine seasons, the Jayhawks have earned 29 Academic All-Big 12 Team appointments.

Henrickson arrived at KU after establishing herself as one of the nation's brightest young coaches at Virginia Tech, where she was head coach for seven seasons and guided the Hokies to a record of 158-62 and seven postseason appearances. Under her leadership, Virginia Tech reached the NCAA tournament five times, the WNIT twice and won 20 or more games every season.

In July 2000, she was the head coach of the gold-medal winning women's USA Basketball team that traveled to Taiwan for the R. William Jones Cup competition. This appointment marked her second stint with a USA Basketball team; she also served as an assistant coach on the Team USA squad which won the silver medal at the 1999 World University Games.

Henrickson, a Willmar, Minnesota, native, graduated from St. Cloud State University in 1986. As a player, she helped SCSU win three Northern Sun Conference championships and advance to three NCAA Division II quarterfinals.

In her four years as a player, SCSU compiled a 97-25 overall record, including a 31-4 mark in her sophomore season. She still ranks among the school leaders in points (4th - 1,731), rebounds (3rd - 995), free throws (1st - 507) and free throw percentage (4th - .790). She also was named to the all-conference team three times. Henrickson served as team captain her junior and senior years.

She earned her master's degree in physical education in 1988 from Western Illinois University while serving as a graduate assistant coach with the women's basketball team.
