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LONE STAR CONFERENCE

Long known as a leader in intercollegiate athletics, the Lone Star Conference™ (LSC) is an innovative athletics conference that aims to provide a superior competitive experience for member institutions and to allow for comprehensive development of student-athletes through academic services and life skills programming. The LSC continues to build upon its proud history while intending to be recognized as the premier NCAA Division II conference in the nation.

The league's mission is to foster student participation and success among member institutions in NCAA Division II intercollegiate athletics as an integral part of each institution's total educational program. The LSC shall pursue student-athlete development with highest regard to the principles of academic excellence, graduation success, sportsmanship, ethical conduct, resourcefulness, community service, gender equity, and diversity.

The LSC - founded on April 25, 1931 - has developed from a five-team conference of Texas-based schools to an 11-member league that spans three states (Texas, Oklahoma and New Mexico).

The league continues to assist its member institutions in the maintenance of intercollegiate athletic programs that are compatible with the highest standards of education and competitive sports.

Throughout the league's 87-year history, various institutions have competed under the LSC banner. Today, only Texas A&M University-Commerce (then East Texas State) remains from the original group that was formed in 1931 when North Texas State, Southwest Texas State, Sam Houston State and Stephen F. Austin withdrew from the old Texas Intercollegiate Athletic Association.

The membership alignment has changed over the years, with current members added from 1954 to 2016. Texas A&M-Kingsville (formerly Texas A&I) joined in 1954, and Angelo State in 1968.

Conference membership remained within the Texas borders until 1984 when Eastern New Mexico was admitted. Since then, the LSC has included members from Arkansas and Oklahoma.

Cameron (1988, 1996) was added near the outset of an expansion phase, while Texas Woman's (1989) and previous members West Texas A&M (1986, 1993) and Tarleton State (1968, 1994) joined the league soon after.

Midwestern State was admitted early in 1995, while Incarnate Word joined the league in 2010. Harding reconnected with the league as an affiliate member in track and field from 2013-15, and McMurtry was an affiliate member in indoor and outdoor track and field and football in 2014.

UT Permian Basin and Western New Mexico were added to the league in 2016, while Lubbock Christian joined as an affiliate member in indoor and outdoor track and field that same year. Oklahoma Panhandle State was an affiliate member in football in 2016.

On July 1, 2019, the LSC will add eight schools as the University of Arkansas-Fort Smith, Dallas Baptist University, Lubbock Christian University, Oklahoma Christian University, Rogers State University, St. Edward's University, St. Mary's University, and Texas A&M International University join the league. With 19 members, the LSC will become the biggest conference in NCAA Division II.

Past members of the LSC include Trinity, Houston, Lamar, Howard Payne, Sul Ross State, McMurtry, Harding, Ouachita Baptist, Central Oklahoma, East Central (Okla.), Northeastern State (Okla.), Southeastern Oklahoma, Southwestern Oklahoma, Abilene Christian and Incarnate Word.

While the LSC has maintained a long-standing tradition of competitive athletic programs for its members, many teams and individuals have gone on to distinguish themselves on the national stage. Entering 2018-19, LSC member institutions have collected 79 NCAA team national championships since the league joined the Division II membership in 1982. Texas A&M-Commerce (football), West Texas A&M (women's indoor track and field), and Texas A&M-Kingsville (men's outdoor track and field) won national titles last year.

The LSC conducts conference championships in 17 sports (eight men and nine women). Men's championships include football, cross country, basketball, baseball, indoor track and field, outdoor track and field, golf and tennis. Women's titles are determined in volleyball, soccer, cross country, basketball, softball, indoor track and field, outdoor track and field, tennis and golf.

The conference office is located in Richardson, Texas, a northern suburb of Dallas. Jay Poerner serves as Commissioner, with assistance from Melanie Robotham (Media Relations), Danielle Anderson (Compliance) and Cheryl Scott (Business).

PRESEASON AWARDS AND COMPOSITE SCHEDULE

Texas A&M-Commerce was selected to prevail by a slim margin as the Lone Star Conference football champions according to the 2018 LSC preseason poll announced Tuesday.

The league's preseason poll reflects the opinions of LSC head coaches and sports information directors, plus various media representatives from throughout the region.

A&M-C, who won the NCAA Division II National Championship last year, earned first place votes on 13 of the 24 ballots to total 201 points. The Lions were 14-1 overall and 7-1 in league play in 2017.

Midwestern State, the defending LSC Champions with a perfect 8-0 league mark, received 10 first-place nods to finish a close second with 200 points following a 10-1 season last year.

Eastern New Mexico ranked third with 142 points in front of Angelo State (136) and Tarleton State (130). Texas A&M-Kingsville (104), West Texas A&M (73), UT Permian Basin (57 with one first-place vote) and Western New Mexico (37) rounded out the poll.

The season kicks off Thursday, August 30 and the LSC has nine teams set to compete in 2018. Each team will play eight conference games to determine the LSC Champion.

Four LSC teams participated in postseason play last season, with A&M-C and MSU advancing to the NCAA Division II playoffs, ASU playing in the C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl, and TSU in the Corsicana Bowl.

PRESEASON AWARDS AND LSC FOOTBALL TEAMS

LSC Football preseason honors announced

Midwestern State's Layton Rabb and Angelo State's Markus Jones were tabbed Lone Star Conference Football Preseason Players of the Year for the 2018 season league officials announced Tuesday.

MSU's Rabb earned Offensive Player of the Year recognition, while ASU's Jones claimed Defensive Player of the Year honors.

The league's preseason awards were selected by a vote of LSC head coaches and sports information directors, plus various media representatives from throughout the region.

Rabb, a 6-5, 225-pound senior quarterback from Llano, Texas, earned second-team all-LSC honors throwing for 3,109 yards with 31 touchdowns last season with just five interceptions. The accounting major was also named to the LSC All-Academic Team in 2017. Rabb returns to lead an attack that rolled up 483.3 yards and 42.5 points per game.

With 17 votes, Rabb was the top choice in front of three others who received votes.

Jones, a 6-3, 255-pound senior defensive end from Crowley, Texas, claimed both Defensive Player of the Year (J.V. Sikes award) and Defensive Lineman of the Year acclaim last season. He led the LSC in sacks with 10.5 and tackles for loss with 18.5 (1.68 per game). Jones recorded 61 total tackles which was third for ASU.

Jones received 13 votes for preseason acclaim over eight others that collected votes.
