Abu Obhakhon, Fairleigh Dickinson

Obhakhon tallied a goal and an assist in Fairleigh Dickinson's 3-2 overtime victory against Bucknell last Wednesday. With the Knights down 2-0 in the second half, the redshirt junior started the comeback by outmuscling a Bucknell defender in the box and scoring his fifth goal of the season in the 64th minute. In overtime, Obhakhon deftly dropped off a pass in transition to Diego Arribas, who fed Fredinho Mompremier for the game-winner in the 92nd minute. Obhakhon is tied for the team lead in goals (5) and points (12), and ranks third in the NEC in both categories.

Arribas played a key role in Fairleigh Dickinson's 3-2 comeback overtime win over Bucknell on Wednesday. He ranks second in the NEC with four assists on the year.
