THE GAME: The Oregon State women's basketball team will face No. 4 Stanford in the Pac-12 Tournament semi-finals Friday evening at 5 p.m. in Las Vegas, Nev.

WHAT'S UP NEXT: With a win on Friday, the Beavers would advance to the finals of the Pac-12 Tournament and would face the winner of the other Pac-12 Tournament semi-final, which will take place Friday evening at 8 p.m.

THE OPPONENT: Oregon State is 9-61 all-time against Stanford. The Cardinal took the only meeting between the two sides this year, Feb. 13 at Gill Coliseum. The Beavers were within four mid-way through the third quarter in that contest, before Stanford pulled away late.

QUICK HITTERS:

- The Beavers are receiving votes in this week's AP Poll
- Oregon State has scored first in 12 of its 17 games this season.
- Over its last nine games, Oregon State has shot 49.8 percent from the floor, while holding its opponents to 37.9 percent shooting.
- The Beavers are shooting a blistering 49.7 percent from beyond the arc over their last nine games.
- Oregon State has won five-straight games and eight out of its last nine
- The Beavers have three wins over ranked opponents in their last four contests
- Oregon State is 176-46 since the start of the 2014-15 season, the ninth highest win total in the nation over that span, trailing only UConn, Notre Dame, Baylor, Maryland, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Stanford and Louisville.
- The Beavers were poised to make their seventh-straight NCAA Tournament last season, prior to the event's cancellation. Oregon State was also slated as a likely host school for the first and second-rounds.
- Oregon State finished fifth in the Pac-12
- The Beavers are one of eight teams in the nation to make each of the last four Sweet 16's, joining UConn, South Carolina, Notre Dame, Baylor, Stanford, UCLA and Mississippi State.
- The Beavers have earned 11 wins over top-10 opponents since the start of 2014-15.

GREAT SCOTT: Scott Rueck Quick Hitters

- Inked a contract extension last offseason that runs through the 2027-28 season.
- 2017 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, becoming one of five coaches in conference history to win the honor multiple times.
- Record at Oregon State is 239-112 making him the second-winningest coach in Oregon State history. Aki Hill holds the Oregon State wins record with 274.
- Rueck's teams have consistently been known for outstanding defense. The Beavers have allowed 58.1 points per game over the course of his tenure. George Fox allowed just 48.3 points per contest in 2009-10, Rueck's final year there, and set a school record with 45.4 points allowed under Rueck in 2007-08.

#AL3AH: Aleah Goodman Quick Hitters

- All-Pac-12
- Earned ESPNW National Player of the Week and Pac-12 Player of the Week on Feb. 22
- Pac-12 Defensive Honorable Mention the last two seasons
- Is currently 19th on Oregon State's career scoring list.
- Is averaging 17.8 points per game and has shot 53.5 percent from 3-point range over her last 10 games.
- Is averaging 16.3 points per game this season, well above the 8.8 she averaged in 2019-20
- Has 23 steals this season, notching at least one in 12 of Oregon State's 17 games.
- Is second in the Pac-12 with 5.1 assists per game.
- Has made 31-straight free throws.
- 2018-19 Pac-12 Sixth Player of the Year, the first one in conference history.
- Is currently first on Oregon State's career 3-point percentage list at 44.0 percent.
- Is first among active Division I players in career 3-point percentage.

TAYLOR MADE: Taylor Jones Quick Hitters

- All-Pac-12 honoree and Pac-12 Defensive Honorable Mention
- Has at least two blocks in 10 of the Beavers' 17 games this season.
- Has scored in double-figures in four-straight games, and is six of the Beavers' last seven
- Has 69 rebounds over the Beavers' last six games.
- Is second the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 57.2 percent and third in blocks per game with 1.7 this season.
- McClain Award Early Season Watch List, honoring the top power forwards in the nation.
- Preseason All-Pac-12 selection
- Named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team, and was Honorable Mention All-Pac-12 and All-Pac-12 Defensive last season

GOFORTH AND CONQUER: Sasha Goforth Quick Hitters

- Pac-12 All-Freshman honoree, and Pac-12 Defensive Honorable Mention
- Earned Pac-12 Freshman of the Week honors twice this season. She joins Jamie Weisner, Sydney Wiese, Mikalya Pivec and Taylor Jones as Beavers to win that award multiple times since it was instated (2012-13)
- Scored in double-figures in each of her first four collegiate games, the first freshman in the Scott Rueck era to accomplish that feat.
- McDonald's All-American

I TALIA YOU WHAT: Talia von Oelhoffen Quick Hitters

- Pac-12 All-Freshman Honorable Mention
- Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on Feb. 22.
- Has scored at least six points in all 10 of her games with the Beavers, including eight double-figure scoring games.
- Has 39 points over the course of her two Pac-12 Tournament games.
- Is averaging 16.2 points per game over her last five contests.
- Is shooting 48.2 percent on the season
- Joined the Beavers in January after graduating high school early and signing a National

SAY TAY KID: Taya Corosdale Quick Hitters

- Has scored at least seven points in three-straight games.
- Returned to the starting lineup this year, after missing almost all of the 2019-20 campaign due to injury.
- 54 of her 79 shots this season have come from beyond the arc.
- Pac-12 Academic Honorable Mention last season
- Averaged 7.8 rebounds per game during Pac-12 play as sophomore

MACK ATTACK: Ellie Mack Quick Hitters

- Came to the Beavers as a graduate transfer from Bucknell and was eligible to play immediately
- Has made 12 of her last 22 3-point attempts
- Has 22 assists over her last eight games
- Started her first 16 games as a Beaver.
- Was the Patriot League Player of the Year in 2019-20
- Two-time All-Patriot League selection

AUSSIE AUSSIE AUSSIE: Jasmine Simmons Quick Hitters

- Started the season with back-to-back double-figure scoring games.
- Is averaging 3.1 points and 2.4 rebounds through the first 15 games of the season, after posting 2.8 points and 2.2 rebounds per contest in 2019-20
- Played a career-high 32 minutes vs. Washington State on Jan. 24.
- Is shooting 48.6 percent from the floor this season.
- Is 7-for-15 from beyond the arc on the season.

SERBIAN SURGE: Jelena Mitrovic Quick Hitters

- Has appeared in all 17 games this season after missing all of 2019-20 due to injury.
- Had arguably her best game as a Beaver on Thursday, finishing with eight points on 4-for-5 shooting to go with six rebounds.
- Is 14-for-26 from the floor over the Beavers' last nine games.
- Is shooting 56.9 percent from 2-point range this season
- Is tied for third on the team with 11 blocks.
- Brother Luka is a professional basketball player.

YO JO: Jovana Subasic Quick Hitters

- Joined the Beavers as a graduate transfer from Washington State is immediately eligible to play
- Has seen action in three of the Beavers' last nine games.
- Played in 31 games for the Cougars last season, making eight starts over the final 10 games of the season.

24-SAVANNAH: Savannah Samuel Quick Hitters

- Has scored in double-figures twice in her last 12 games.
- Did not play on Thursday for the first time this season
- Scored seven points vs. Stanford, her highest output over the last 10 games.
- Blocked three shots vs. Oregon.

SHE'S THE MANNEN: Noelle Mannen Quick Hitters

- Walked on at Oregon State last summer, after attending the University of San Francisco in 2018-19 (did not play basketball)
- Has appeared six games this season.
- Scored her first points of the season vs. Arizona on Jan. 17
- Scored 10 points on 3-for-4 shooting vs. Southern Utah last season.

UPSIDE BROWN: Kennedy Brown Quick Hitters

- Preseason All-Pac-12 selection
- Missed the last part of the 2019-20 season due to an ACL injury suffered Feb. 7 vs. Arizona State.
- At the time of her injury, she was second in the Pac-12 in blocks.
- Is tied for fifth on Oregon State's freshman blocks list.
- 2019 McDonalds All-American

IN THE PAC:

- The Beavers are 93-28 in Pac-12 play since the start of the 2014-15 season, and 101-29 in their last 130 conference games.
- Beaver players have earned 15 All-Pac-12 First-Team nods over the last seven seasons, including a pair this season.
- Head coach Scott Rueck is one of five coaches in Pac-12 history to win the John R. Wooden Coach of the Year Award multiple times.
