#### BASEBALL – Sean Aspinall (Azusa Pacific)

2018 Google Cloud Academic All-America Division II Baseball (third team) and earned All-PacWest second team honors... Ranked fourth in the PacWest in total bases (126), fifth in home runs (13) and RBIs (50), and 11th in batting average (.352)... Led APUs offense in batting (.352), hits (70), and RBIs (50)... Ranked second on team in home runs (13)... Registered teams longest hitting streak (17 games)... Led the team in multi-RBI games (15) and second on team in multi-hit games (21)... Had perfect fielding percentage in 102 chances... In 7th inning and later, batted .421 (24-for-57) with 12 extra-base hits (5 HR), 10 walks, 16 runs & 16 RBIs... Missed all of 2016 season to summer-league injury the previous year and battled through injury-plagued 2017 season to return in 2018 as one of the teams most productive players with multiple game-winning hits.

## MEN'S BASKETBALL - Brandon Simister (Dixie State)

2018 CoSIDA Second Team Academic All-America selection ... also a three-time CoSIDA Academic All-District and Academic All-PacWest pick ... was a first team all-PacWest and second team D2CCA all West region selection this past season after finishing as DSU's second-leading scorer at 15.1 points per game ... scored in double figures in 23 of his 28 starts with a team-high seven 20-plus point outings, and he led the team in scoring 13 times overall ... was named the 2018 PacWest Tournament Most Outstanding Player after pouring in a career-high 28 points in DSU's tourney clinching win over CBU (3/3) ... also tallied 25 points with a DSU single-game record-tying six 3-pointers in a win over Holy Names (2/19), and followed that up with a game-high 19 points, 13 in the second half, in DSU's PacWest title-clinching win at Point Loma (2/24), which earned him PacWest Player of the Week honors ... closed his season ranked 11th-nationally in free throw percentage with a DSU single-season record 90.2 percent clip, which included breaking DSU and PacWest single-game records with 18-straight free throws made in a win at Concordia-Irvine (Dec. 18), going 18-for-18 overall ... finished his four-year career owning the DSU "trifecta" as the single game (co-leader with 6), single-season (67 in 2017-18) and career (165) 3FGM leader. He is also DSU's career leader in free throw percentage (.8708) and is ranked in the top-10 all-time in 13 DSU career statistical categories overall, including second all-time in free throws made (337), third in assists (307), third in career 3-point percentage (.424), and fourth in scoring (1,145 pts).

### WOMEN'S BASKETBALL - Natalie Diaz (Dominican)

Named Division II Conference Commissioners Association Second Team All-American...Was named to the WBCA All-America Honorable Mention...Earned two PacWest Player of the Week awards for Nov. 27-Dec. 3 and Dec. 1117...Named 2018 PacWest Player of the Year...Named All-PacWest First Team...Named to the All-PacWest Women's

Basketball Championships Team...Set a single-season Dominican record with 722 points during the NCAA Division II era...Appeared in all 30 games with 28 starts...Finished the season with 15 double-doubles...Ranked third nationally with 24.1 points per game.

Placed 3rd in the PacWest XC Championships, earning All-PacWest first team honors... Won 2 meets (Biola Invitational, Coyote Invitational).

### WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY - Emeline Delanis (California Baptist)

2017 PacWest Runner of the Year and individual champion ... led CBU to its fourth-straight PacWest Championship, first-ever West Region Championship and a third-place finish at the DII Championship ... grabbed CoSIDA Academic All-District and All-American honors ... took fifth overall at nationals for All-American honors.

## MEN'S GOLF - Jayce Frampton (Dixie State)

collected second team all-PacWest honors after he posted two individual event victories in Hawaii during the fall season ... claimed medalist honors at the DSU Island Invitational (10/23-24) and followed that up with a win at the Hawaii Hilo/Dennis Rose Intercollegiate (10/27-28), which earned him back-to-back PacWest Player of the Week awards (10/26 and 11/2) ... helped lead DSU to its third PacWest title in four seasons and to the program's 10th-straight NCAA Regional appearance ... posted a t-4th finish at the UCSD SoCal Intercollegiate (3/26-27) to help pace DSU to a team runner-up showing ... played in all 10 events this season posted five top-15 individual showings ... finished second on the team with a 73.93 scoring average in 29 competitive rounds and finished tied on the team with 11 rounds of par or better.

### **WOMEN'S GOLF – Samantha Martirez (California Baptist)**

Martirez was a first-team All-PacWest selection and ranked 35th in Golfstat's NCAA Division II individual rankings this year... The 2017 PacWest Freshman of the Year averaged a 75.30 in 12 tournaments and 27 rounds this season... The 2017 individual conference champion has a total of eight top20 finishes as an individual, seven top-10 finishes and two in the top three, with the other two exceptions being a 24th and 33rd finish... She won the NCAA Division I Lady Mustang Intercollegiate hosted by Cal Poly and is a two-time PacWest Golfer of the Week, which tied for a conference high this season... Martirez also took fifth at the PacWest Championships for All-Tournament honors.

### MEN'S SOCCER - Wiktor Lasota (Point Loma)

All-American honorable mention...Led the PacWest and ranked 13th in NCAA Division II with eight shutouts, despite missing three starts...Registered an .818 save percentage (22nd NCAA) and ranked 14th nationally with a .669 goals against average...Helped PLNU post its best season in program history with a 16-match unbeaten streak and tying the school record with 14 wins...The Sea Lions also earned the right to host the NCAA West Regional.

#### **WOMEN'S SOCCER – Darian Murdock (Dixie State)**

earned 2017 CoSIDA First Team Academic All-America honors and was a 2016 CoSIDA Second Team Academic All-America pick ... also a two-time CoSIDA Academic All-District 8 (2016-17) and three-time Academic All-PacWest selection ... was named the 2017 PacWest Scholar Athlete for women's soccer ... capped an award-winning season as she repeated as PacWest Women's Soccer Player of the Year and earned D2CCA West Region Player of the Year and D2CCA Second Team All-American honors ... finished the 2017 regular season ranked in the top-10 nationally in five statistical categories overall, including single-season school records for goals scored (19), game-winning goals (8), and points (42) ... her name is etched atop five DSU single-season statistical categories this year, including becoming the first player in

program history to register three hat tricks in one season, and in all three instances she was named PacWest Player of the Week ... scored at least one goal in seven of her last nine starts, and in 11 of 18 matches overall with five multi-goal outings, while DSU played to a 10-1-0 record when she found the back of the net ... ended her four years as the Dixie State's career leader in game-winning goals (16) and finished third all-time in career goals (42), career points (94), career shots (204) and career shots on goal (104).

Hackett was named the 2017 Player of the Year in the NCAA Division II West Region by the AVCA and in the PacWest Player of the Year... She also named a CoSIDA Academic All-American for the second year in a row... She made both All-American teams this year and was a first-team pick in the West Region by both outlets... As a senior, she posted 457 points (4.62 a set), with 384 kills (3.88 a set) on a .271 percentage, 60 blocks and 35 aces... Added 260 digs (2.63 a set) ... Posted NCAA-era career program records with 1,687 kills (4.04 a set) and 112 aces, while adding 892 digs (2.13 a set) and 279 blocks over four years at CBU.
