KUTZTOWN

Players to Watch

QB Collin DiGalbo – Threw for two scores and ran for another vs Millersville. Gained 243 total yards (156 pass, 87 rush).

RB Craig Reynolds – Reynolds continues to do everything, posting 58 rushing yards, 47 receiving yards and 2 TDs, plus 58 punt return yards including a 53-yard TD, his first career punt return touchdown of his career.

LB Tajier Jefferson – Totaled 12 tackles, 5 of those solo with 2 TFL last week. Jefferson's 34 tackles on the season are 12th in the PSAC.

Game Notes: The Golden Bears put together a 35-point second quarter against Millersville to pull away 41-21. Kutztown has won three in a row since the season opening loss to Assumption 31-28. The defense ranks 3rd in total defense in the PSAC.

WEST CHESTER

Players to Watch

QB A.J. Long – PSAC East Offensive Athlete of Week 4 after making his first start and gaining 198 yards and 2 TDs through the air and 181 yards and 2 TDs on the ground.

WR Dan Neuhaus – Caught two passes, both for TD's (44 & 6 yards) to give Long and Neuhaus their first two touchdowns of their careers.

LB Tyler Morrissey – Recorded a season-high 16 tackles (8 solo, 8 assisted) and 2 TFL for -3 yards.

Game Notes: West Chester used a touchdown pass and run from Long in third quarter to down Lock Haven 35-14. The Golden Rams have the 4th highest scoring offense in Div. II with 47.5 points per game and the second most points over four games with 190.

LOCK HAVEN

Players to Watch

QB Jimmy Strickland – Went 13-of-17 for 196 yards and 1 TD against West Chester.

RB Ralph Hyland – Hyland rushed for 16 carries, 98 yards and a TD with two receptions for 15 yards.

DB Isaiah Flamer – Led the team in tackles last week vs West Chester and is 3rd in the PSAC and 11th nationally with 45 total tackles.

Game Notes: Lock Haven seeks to avoid going 0-5 in consecutive season. LHU fell to SHIP, 38-16, last season. Following the loss, the Bald Eagles ripped off 4 wins in their next 6 games. Lock Haven will travel to Shippensburg to finish off their toughest three-game stretch of the schedule.

SHIPPENSBURG

Players to Watch

QB Ryan Zapoticky – Completed 24-of-30 passes for 370 yards and 2 TDs. He also rushed for 52 yards on 7 carries. His 1,319 passing yard is 5th in NCAA Div. II.

RB Colin McDermott – McDermott rushed for a career-high 121 yards and 3 TDs against East Stroudsburg filling in for Cole Chiappelle.

WR Winston Eubanks – Eubanks has 6 receiving touchdowns ranking him tied for 2nd in the NCAA. His 537 receiving yards ranks him 5th nationally and 1st in the PSAC.

Game Notes: Shippensburg has pitched two shutouts in a row beating Clarion 31-0 in Week 3 and East Stroudsburg 40-0 Week 4. The Red Raiders are ranked 5th nationally in scoring defense allowing a mere 10 points per game.

Players to Watch

QB Ben Moser – Went for 23-of-44 and 247 yards and has yet to throw an interception in 75 passes in two starts.

WR Tim Wilson – Wilson was 1 of 10 players to catch a pass vs Shippensburg. Wilson led his team with 5 catches.

RB Jaymar Anderson – Anderson failed to rush for 100 yards all season last week. Anderson ranks 4th in the PSAC with 103.8 rushing yards per game.

Game Notes: East Stroudsburg was shutout for the first time since 2000 when it fell to Shippensburg, 40-0. The Warriors and Wolves both sit at 1-3 riding 3-game losing streaks.

CHEYNEY

Players to Watch

QB Dominic Trautz – Trautz is T-3rd with 9 TD passes and needs 109 yards to surpass the 1,000-yard mark.

RB Brandon French – Carried the ball 12 times for 55 yards and 1-yard TD. French leads the team with 149 yards and 2 TDs on the season.

DL Keyson Dingle – Dingle is T-3rd in the PSAC with 5.5 TFL and 1st with TFL yards (53). He also leads the team in sacks with 2.

Game Notes: The Wolves rank 9th in the PSAC in scoring offense averaging 26.3 points per game and 14th with 309.3 yards per game. Cheyney is on a 3-game slide, averaging 16.3 points per game in those losses.

Players to Watch

DE Chris Gary – Named PSAC East Defensive Athlete of Week 4 after his monster performance of 5 tackles, 4 TFL for -36 yards and 3 sacks plus 1 forced fumble that was returned 51 yards the other way.

DB Eric Schwartz – Posted 5 tackles after his Week 3 PSAC East Defensive Athlete of Week award. He leads the team with 22 tackles.

RB Qmac Quiteh – Rushed 17 times for 108 yards and two scores of 4 and 15 against Cheyney in Week 4. This was Quiteh's 2nd game rushing over the century mark.

Game Notes: Bloomsburg has had consecutive PSAC East Defensive Athletes of the Week in their 3-game winning streak. The Husky defense ranks 5th in the PSAC in scoring defense with 23.3.

MILLERSVILLE

Players to Watch

QB Stephen Flannagan – Completed 18-of-26 passes for 157 yards, 2 TDs, and 1 INT. Flannagan was sacked 5 times and rushed 16 times for 33 yards.

LB Sean Dugan – Recorded 8 tackles and a forced fumble vs Kutztown. Dugan is 2nd in the PSAC with 48 tackles and 9th in NCAA Div. II.

DE Tommy Halloway – Led the Marauders in tackles with 9 last game, also recorded a TFL and a sack. Halloway now has 22 tackles, 3.5 TFL and 3 sacks on the season.

Game Notes: Millersville is back at home after a 41-21 loss to Kutztown. In the PSAC, Millersville is averaging 26.3 points per game and allowing 36 per game.

Players to Watch

RB Marc Jones – Broke the PSAC single game rushing record of 350 yards from 1982, with a 354-yard and 4 TD performance on the ground. Jones also caught 4 passes for 95 yards and a score. Named Div. II Athlete of the Week.

QB Jimmy Keefe – Completed 10-of-19 passes for 182 yards and 2 TDs vs Slippery Rock.

LB Anthony Howard – Led the team in tackles (12), TFL (1) and sacks (1) in Week 4. Howard leads the team and PSAC with 49 tackles, 8th in Div. II.

Game Notes: Gannon's 399-yard rushing attack kept them in a close game with Slippery Rock before falling 49-45 after Marcus Johnson scored a 73-yard TD. The Golden Knights are 1st in rushing in the PSAC.

MERCYHURST

Players to Watch

LB Kaz Struna – Struna was selected as the PSAC West Defensive Athlete of the Week after posting 10 tackles, 3 TFL and 2 sacks. His TFL and sacks combined for -21 yards.

LB Alex Zacharyasz – Led the team in tackles against Clarion with 12 total tackles and half a TFL and sack.

RB Garrett Owens – Owens only ran the ball 5 times against Clarion but had 77 yards and a 70-yard score.

Game notes: Mercyhurst was in control of the their game against Clarion for most of the competition. Clarion battled back down 21-10 before scoring and connecting on a 2-point conversion. The Lakers defense stood tall and earned their 2nd win of the season. QB Doug Altavilla is coming off his best performance of the season tossing 2 TDs and 224 yards with no turnovers.

Players to Watch

QB Asianti Woulard – Completed 13-of-30 passes for 195 yards and 1 TD. Woulard also tossed 2 INTs and ran for 50 yards and a score on 12 carries.

DL Brandon Vocco – Led the team last week with 1.5 TFL and 1 sack against Mercyhurst. He also added 5 tackles and now has 23 tackles, 2 TFL, 1.5 sacks.

WR Greg Leonard – Leonard caught 2 passes for 56 yards and a TD giving him his 2nd TD in 3 games. Leonard leads the team in receptions (12), yards (274), TDs (2), and yards per game (68.5).

Game Notes: Clarion starts off the year 0-4 for the first time since 2011 when the team went 0-5. Clarion will look for their first divisional win against Edinboro.

EDINBORO

Players to Watch

QB Jake Sisson – Sisson ranks 5th in the PSAC with 1,015 passing yards and T-3rd with 9 passing TDs.

RB Walter Fletcher – Fletcher rushed for 50 yards on 14 carries last week. He ranks 2nd in the PSAC with 431 rushing yards and has two 100-yard games this season.

DB Zuril Hendrick – Hendrick leads the country with 5 INTs, 106 return yards and 1 TD return. The ballhawk had his first game of the season without an INT vs IUP.

Game Notes: Edinboro started the season 2-0 holding both opponents to three points each, but have surrendered 100 points over the last two games. Sisson and the Edinboro offense will look to pick up the 9th-ranked PSAC offense (369.5 yards per game) against the 11th-ranked Clarion defense (400.3 yards per game).

QB Lenny Williams – Williams threw for 274 yards and 4 TDs on 18-of-27 passing. He also added 56 yards on the ground. The 2016 All-PSAC Second Team QB has 956 yards and 10 TD passes on the season.

WR Jojo Gause – Gause caught 3 of Williams' 4 passing touchdowns totaling 6 receptions for 84 yards against Edinboro.

LB Damon Lloyd – Lloyd picked off his first two career passes last week and totaled six tackles to give him the 3rd most tackles on the team with 27.

Game Notes: The Crimson Hawks climbed to #3 in the media polls after a 38-7 win vs Edinboro. IUP will have sole focus on Seton Hill after the Griffins nearly upset California 41-44.

Players to Watch

QB Christian Strong – Threw for a career-high 476 yards on 29-of-48 through the air with 5 TDs and 1 INT.

WR Michael Elardo – Caught 2 TD's from Strong and 6 more for 188 yards total. Leads the team with 22 receptions for 401 yards and 3 TDs.

WR Timothy Knuettel – Ranks 2nd on the team with 18 receptions for 190 yards and 63.3 yards per game.

Game Notes: Seton Hill lost a heartbreaker 44-41 to then #5/6 California after QB Michael Keir ran in a 2-yard TD with 18 seconds left trailing 41-37. Strong leads the PSAC's 6th ranked offense (426.8 yards per game).

Players to Watch

QB Michael Keir – Had his first game of the season where he didn't throw a TD. Keir finished 22-of-35 for 273 yards and a rushing TD against Seton Hill in Week 4.

RB Nick Grisson – Grisson ranks 8th in the PSAC with 296 rushing yards and ran for his 1st 100-yard rushing game of the season last week with 129 yards and 2 TDs.

K Will Brazill – Scored 14 of Cal's 44 points last week knocking down 3 Field Goals (26, 41, 47) and 5 extra points. Brazil is a perfect 8-of-8 and owns the longest FG of the season in the PSAC (47).

Game Notes: Cal narrowly escaped an upset last week vs Seton Hill with a Keir TD with 18 seconds remaining. Cal will now have their toughest test of the season at #17/18 Slippery Rock. Cal beat Slippery Rock 52-26 behind Keir's 4 TD passes. The offense is averaging 40.8 points per game (4th) and the defense is allowing 25.5 (7th).

SLIPPERY ROCK

Players to Watch

QB Tanner Garry – Threw for career-highs in pass attempts (50), pass completions (33), passing yards (518) and passing TDs (5) against Gannon last week to earn PSAC West C-Athlete of Week 4.

WR Marcus Johnson – Set a career-long with a 73-yard game-winning TD against Gannon and also caught 4 TDs, a career-high. Johnson caught 10 passes for 183 yards and returned a kickoff 88 yards for a score to total 319 yards and 5 TDs last week.

WR Milly Raye – Caught 11 passes for 125 yards and 1 TD last week making the win over Gannon his 3rd 100-yard game in his last 4.

Game Notes: Slippery Rock used a 73-yard connection from Garry to Johnson to avoid an upset at Gannon, 49-45. The Rock gained 597 yards of total offense and allowed Gannon to gain 585 yards, 399 of those rushing.
