- The Huskies hit the road for each of the next two weekends for NSIC games.
- SCSU takes on Minnesota Crookston on Saturday, Jan. 9, at 4 p.m. at Lysaker Gymnasium
- The Huskies then continue the road swing and travel to Bemidji State for a 3 p.m. contest against the Beavers on Jan. 10 at Sanford Center.

Last Time Out Notables

- The Huskies had a busy and productive week with wins in two of the three games
- The team started the week with a 106-49 victory Crown College on Dec. 30.
- The 106 points against Crown College was the most points for the program since scoring 107 against Bemidji State during the 2009-10 season.
- The team's 43 made field goals and 85 attempts were both season highs.
- The 43 made field goals was the most since the team also hit 43 shots against Dakota State during the 2008-09 season.
- The Huskies also recorded 50 or more rebounds in a game for the first time this season with 54 against the Storm.
- The 54 rebounds were the most for the program since hauling in 58 against Crossroads College last season.

- The team's 30 assists were the most for the team since getting 32 helpers against Dakota State during the 2008 season.
- The 106 points against CC marked the team's sixth time over 100 since the 2002-03 season.
- The 49 points allowed to Crown College was the lowest opponent point total since Iowa Wesleyan was limited to 47 points against SCSU last season.
- The 57-point margin of victory was the largest for the program since the 1990-91 team had a 70-point victory over Macalester (144-74).
- Redshirt freshman Gage Davis led five SCSU players in double figures with 21 points. It was his sixth 20-point performance of the season.
- Redshirt sophomore Seth Mortag had a career evening in his first start of the season with 19 points and 11 rebounds for his first career double-double.
- Mortag became the fourth different member of the team to record a double-double this season
- Junior Scottie Stone chipped in 19 points, four rebounds and three assists in the win
- Senior Eddie Alcantara just missed a double-double with 13 points and nine rebounds.
- It was Alcantara's first time in double figures since the first game of the season against Missouri Southern (11/13/15).

- The game against Missouri Southern also marked the last game that Alcantara recorded nine or more rebounds in a game.
- Freshman Brindley Theisen totaled 10 points to reach double figures for the third time in his last four games.
- Junior Chuckie Smith and sophomore Andy Foley tied for the team lead with six assists each against the Storm.
- The team unveiled the third different starting lineup of the season against Crown College (Mark Hall - G, Scottie Stone - G, Gage Davis - F, Seth Mortag - F and Jon Averkamp - C).
- The Huskies then fell to Minnesota State by a 86-71 score on Saturday, Jan. 2
- SCSU got down early and never were able to climb back to get to within 10 for much of the second half.
- Eddie Alcantara became the fourth different member of the team to lead the squad in scoring in a contest with his career-high 20 points against the Mavericks.
- Alcantara shot an efficient 6-for-9 from the field (67 percent)
- He also led the team in rebounding for the fourth time this season with his seven boards.
- Gage Davis was the only other Huskies' player to reach double figures with his 19 points.
- Davis also led the squad with his four assists
- SCSU was outboarded in the game, 37-28, for only the fourth time this season.
- The Huskies completed the four game homestand that start just before the holidays with a 96-71 win on Sunday, Jan. 3.
- Gage Davis became the first member of the team to score 30 or more

points in a game this season with his 32 points against Concordia-St. Paul.

- Davis' 32 points makes him the first SCSU player to record 30 points since Jordan Poydras scored 30 points against Minot last season.
- The 32 points scored by Davis was the most points scored by a player since Jordan Poydras scored 32 against Minot State during the 2014 season.
- Davis has now led the team in scoring in seven games this season, scored 20 or more points six times and reached double figures in all 14 games.
- Davis also tied his season-high with 12 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the campaign versus Concordia-St. Paul.
- He also led the team in assists with seven helpers.
- On the week, Davis led the team in points (72), rebounds (23), assists (14), steals (7) while averaging 24 points per game and shooting 56.8 percent from the field, 37.5 percent from three-point range (6-for-16) and 94.1 percent from the free throw line (16-for-17)
- Scottie Stone rebounded from a season-low three points against Minnesota State with 22 points against CSP.
- The 22 points marked Stone's 11th career 20-point performance.
- Junior Mark Hall reached double figures in the game for the seventh time this season with his 10 points.
- Junior center Nebojsa Stanojevic recorded a team season-high four blocks against the Golden Bears
- Eleven of the 13 players that earned playing time against CSP hit at least one shot.
- SCSU went 19-for-20 in free throws against Concordia-St. Paul and have hit 43 of their 47 free throws attempts over the last three games (91.5 percent)

Davis Earned NSIC POW Honors

- Redshirt freshman Gage Davis was named the NSIC's North Division Player of the Week on Dec. 7 after averaging 25.5 points and 11.5 rebounds a contest in the team's conference wins over Bemidji State and Minnesota Crookston
- Davis is the first SCSU basketball player to take home the weekly award since Jordan Poydras was named on Feb. 9, 2015

Husky Paws / Season Notables

- Gage Davis' 32 points against Concordia St. Paul (1/3/16) were the most points scored by an SCSU player since Jordan Poydras tallied 32 against Minot State during the 2014 season (1/18/14).
- The 12 rebounds from Davis against the Golden Bears (1/3/16) were the most for the program since he had the same number of rebounds against Bemidji State (12/4/15).
- The SCSU team was able to knock down 15-of-25 three-point attempts (60 percent) in the victory against Minnesota Crookston (12/5/15).
- The 15 made threes were the most made threes for the team since knocking down 16 against Winona State during the 2010-11 season (1/9/11).
- The 60 percent shooting from three-point range was the highest percentage the team has shot since they hit 64.3 percent (9-for-14) against Ashford during the 2012-13 campaign (12/29/12).
- SCSU shot 53.7 percent from the field (36-67) in the win against the Golden Eagles was the best shooting percentage since they hit 63.9 percent (39-for-61) of their shots against Wayne State last season (1/17/15).
- Gage Davis' three straight double-doubles from Nov. 28 to Dec. 5 was the longest streak of double-doubles for the program since Andrew Bernstetter also had three straight during the 2011 season (from 1/3/11 to 1/9/11).
- The Huskies enter the week leading the NSIC in total of offensive rebounds with 191 and with an average of 13.6

offensive rebounds a game.

- The Huskies, after some sharp shooting from the free throw line over the last few weeks, have the top free throw shooting team in the league 76.3 percent (184-for-241)
- The program also ranks in the top half of the conference in assists (16.6 - 2nd), blocked shots (3.9 - 2nd), attendance (1,437 - 3rd), field goal percentage (47.1 - 5th), rebounding margin (6.1 - 4th), scoring (83.4 - 5th), three-point percentage (37.2 - 7th), turnover margin (1.36 - 4th), turnovers per game (10.9 - 5th), assist to turnover ratio (1.5 - 5th), scoring margin (7.6 - 6th), total rebounds (544 - 4th) and total steals (82 - 6th).
- Gage Davis is placed second in the NSIC in scoring with his average of 20.3 points a game. His average is good for 59th nationally.
- Davis has made the second-most field goals in the league with 110 and is shooting 57.9 percent from the field (110-for-190). His shooting percentage is seventh in the conference and his 31.8 minutes per game is fourth in the league.
- Davis also is shooting 48.2 percent from three-point range (27-for-56) to place eighth in the NSIC and ranks ninth in steals (18).
- Scottie Stone is ranked seventh in the league in scoring with his average of 17.0 points a contest.
- Stone is also fifth in the league in total points with 238 on the most attempts (215) in the NSIC.
- Stone also ranks 10th in the conference with his 25 made threes.
- He also is third in free throw percentage at 86.8 percent (46-for-53) and 10th in minutes played 30.8
- Jon Averkamp is 10th in the league with an average of 2.1 offensive rebounds per game despite coming off the bench for most of the season and only averaging 18.1 minutes per game.
- Nebojsa Stanojevic is fifth in the league with his average of 1.4 blocks per game and 15th in the league with his average of 1.9 offensive rebounds a contest.
- Seth Mortag is also tied for 15th in the league with an aver-

age of 1.9 offensive rebounds per game.

- Gage Davis is eighth in defensive rebounds with an average of 5.1 per contest.

Opponent Notes / Last Meeting

- The Huskies are 25-2 all-time against Minnesota Crookston in a series that started during the 1995-96 season.
- One of the two all-time losses to the Golden Eagles was in the first meeting on the road last season by an 99-85 score.
- The other happened during the 2013 season by a 80-77 margin.
- SCSU defeated Minnesota Crookston by a 97-68 score earlier this season (12/5/15) at Halenbeck Hall with Scottie Stone leading the team with 26 points and Gage Davis chipping in 22 points and 11 rebounds.
- The team shot 53.7 percent from the field in the game (36-for-67) and also knocked down 60 percent of their threes (15-for-25).
- SCSU holds a 98-40 lead against Bemidji State in a series that began during the 1923-24 season.
- The Huskies defeated the Beavers by an 80-62 score earlier this season (12/4/15) at home with Gage Davis putting up 29 points and 12 rebounds.
- Scottie Stone also had a double-double in the game with 19 points and 10 rebounds.
- Minnesota Crookston is coached by Dan Weisse, who is 10-29 thus far in his first two years of running the team.
- UMC comes into the game having lost four straight games and seven of their last eight contests
- The Golden Eagles are led by senior Derrick Redd and his average of 11.8 points per game
- Sophomore C.J. Polk is also averaging in double figures at 11.3 points per game and leads the team with 14 steals.
- Kobe Critchley has a team-high 33 assists
- Gable Smith is the top rebounder with 61 and also leads the squad with his 19 blocks.
- BSU is coached by Mike Boschee, who is in his fourth year-leading the program. He spent the first eight years of his career coaching at Central College (Iowa). Central College is where SCSU head coach Matt Reimer went to school and began his student coaching career.
- Boschee is 50-46 since taking over the Beavers' program and 6-6 so far this season.
- The team has lost five of the last seven games since facing St. Cloud State in early December.
- Five of the team's six wins this season have come at home.
- Junior Ben Best leads the team in scoring at 13.8 points per game.
- Best is also the club's top rebounder (75) and shot blocker (18).
- Senior D.J. Anderson has totaled a team-high 41 assists and 18 steals.

Coach / Team Notes

- Head coach Matt Reimer is 14 games into his second year leading the program and has an 24-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in the NSIC in his career.
- The program placed third in the North Division and sixth overall in the standing in 2014-15 in the NSIC.
- Reimer's winning record in his first year made him the third straight SCSU men's basketball coach to have a winning first season with the program (Kevin Schlagel - 17-10 in 1997-98 and Butch Raymond - 15-13 in 1984-85) and the 11th overall (George Lynch - 10-0 in 1922-23; John Weisman - 9-5 in 1929-30; Ed Colletti 7-3 in 1933-34; Les Luymes

13-8 in 1950-51; Ken Novak 13-10 in 1954-55; Paul Meadows 16-9 in 1955-56; Red Severson 21-5 in 1958-59; Noel Olson 18-9 in 1969-70; Butch Raymond 15-13 in 1984-85; Kevin Schlagel 17-10 in 1997-98)

- The winning season was the 20th consecutive one for the program.
- The program has won 17 or more games 18 times since 1994-95
- The Huskies advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2014-15 NSIC/Stanford Basketball Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven seasons.
- SCSU is picked sixth overall and third in the NSIC Division in the annual preseason poll in 2015-16.
- The St. Cloud State men's basketball team received some preseason recognition and were ranked eighth nationally in the *Sporting News Yearbook Division II 2015-16 Preseason Poll*

Player Notes

- The team's top returning player from last year is Scottie Stone, who played in all 30 games with 18 starts last year.
- Stone ranked second on the team and 13th in the conference with his average of 14.4 points per game, while shooting 45.9 percent from the field (150-for-327), 45.1 percent from three-point range (73-for-162) and 82.9 percent from the free throw line (58-for-70).
- Stone's three-point percentage placed him ninth in the NSIC.
- He led the team in scoring in eight games including career-high 29 points against University of Mary
- Senior forward Eddie Alcantara played in all 30 games with 26 starts in 2014-15
- Alcantara averaged a team-high 5.1 rebounds a game and posted a pair of double-doubles with 15 points and 10 rebounds against Iowa Wesleyan College (12/30/14) and 14 points and 10 rebounds against Northern State (2/13/15). He had his third career double-double this season with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Missouri Southern (11/13/15)
- He ranked 20th in the conference in rebounding with his average of 5.1 per game in 2014-15
- Junior guard Chuckie Smith played in all 30 games last season and made 19-for-57 threes (33.3 percent) and 19-of-20 shots from the line (95 percent)
- Smith scored a season-high 17 points against Crossroads College (12/2/14)
- Sophomore Jon Averkamp played in 26 games and averaged 12.6 minutes a contest.
- He scored 10 points in three different games and tallied a double-double of 10 points and 10 rebounds against Crossroads College (12/2/14)
- Sophomore Andy Foley played in all 30 games as a freshman and scored a season-high 11 points against Crossroads College (12/2/14).
- Josh Johnson scored seven points and hit 3-for-5 shots from the field in five games in 2014-15. He played for the first time this season against Northland College (11/24/15).
- Drew Hansen picked up two rebounds and two points in four contests last year. He earned playing time for the first time this season against Minnesota Crookston (12/5/15), Crown College (12/30/15) and Concordia St. Paul (1/3/16)
- Seth Mortag was injured and sat out the 2014-15 season for a redshirt campaign, but averaged 3.4 points and 1.8

rebounds per game as a freshman.

- The program also welcomes in seven new players this season including three Division I transfers in Gage Davis (IFPW), Kurt Hall (Toledo) and Mark Hall (Illinois State)
- SCSU also added in 7'0" transfer center Nebojsa Stanojevic (Seton Hill) plus true freshman recruits in Brindley Theisen, Adam Heede-Andersen and Jake Mussman.
- Mussman is the son of current SCSU football offensive coordinator Chris Mussman.

Up Next

- The program continues the road swing next weekend and travels to Augustana on Jan. 15 for an 8 p.m. contest at Sioux Falls Arena and then onto Wayne State on Jan. 16 for a 6 p.m. game at Rice Auditorium.
- SCSU's next home game will be on Jan. 22 against the University of Mary at 8 p.m. at Halenbeck Hall
