



Postgame Notes
No. 3 Houston 84, No. 6 UCF 56
Records: Houston (25-6); UCF (19-13)

Houston advances to face No. 2-seeded Wichita State in Saturday's semifinal round. The Cougars are now 2-0 against UCF this season.

Houston is the first No. 3 seed to win a game in the American Athletic Conference Championship history. In the first four conference tournaments, the No. 3 seeds were a combined 0-4.

Houston F Devin Davis shot 6-for-6 in the first half, finishing with a total of 16 points.

Houston outscored UCF in second chance points 12-3.

UCF G B.J. Taylor scored a team high 16 points, his 56th career game with double figure scoring.

The Cougars had five players in double figures scoring.

The 84 points scored by Houston were the most points allowed by UCF all season.
