

Postgame Notes No. 3 Houston 84, No. 6 UCF 56 Records: Houston (25-6); UCF (19-13)

Houston advances to face No. 2-seeded Wichita State in Saturday's semifinal round. The Cougars are now 2-0 against UCF this season.

Houston is the first No. 3 seed to win a game in the American Athletic Conference Championship history. In the first four conference tournaments, the No. 3 seeds were a combined 0-4.

Houston F Devin Davis shot 6-for-6 in the first half, finishing with a total of 16 points.

Houston outscored UCF in second chance points 12-3.

UCF G B.J. Taylor scored a team high 16 points, his $56^{\rm th}$ career game with double figure scoring.

The Cougars had five players in double figures scoring.

The 84 points scored by Houston were the most points allowed by UCF all season.
