No. 7 BRUINS At USC on Thursday and Saturday — UCLA (2-2), ranked No. 7 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll, will travel across town for a pair of Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) matches against USC (1-0) --- on Thursday (Galen Center) and Saturday (Galen Pavilion). Both matches are set to begin at 5 p.m. The Trojans dealt the Bruins a 1-3 setback last Saturday in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom. Last season, UCLA defeated USC in four sets in Pauley Pavilion in the only meeting of 2020. The Trojans have defeated UCLA 3-2 in the last two meetings played in the Galen Center in 2019 and 2018. The Bruins won the 2017 away match in straight sets.

UCLA will return home next week to host Concordia, Irvine. All of this season's home matches are scheduled to be played in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom. No fans will be present for the 2021 UCLA home matches.

LAST MEETING -- Last Saturday, the Trojans outthit the Bruins .246 to .175 to come away with a 30-28, 32-30, 19-25, 26-24 win in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom. Sam Kobrine led UCLA with a career-best 14 kills. Ethan Champlin added 13 kills and three blocks. Last season, UCLA defeated USC in four sets in Pauley Pavilion in the lone meeting (23-25,25-22,25-14,25-10). The Bruins outthit the Trojans .391 to .212 while enjoying a 10.5 to 1.0 edge in total blocks. Cole Ketrzynski had 15 kills to lead the attack.

NOTES -- Sam Kobrine posted a career high with 14 kills and tied his career best with 10 digs in a loss to USC while splitting time between hitter and setter positions ... **Ethan Champlin** had a career-high 13 kills against USC (2/13) ... he was named Molten/Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Defensive Player of the Week (2/8) after his performance at BYU - 15 digs, 6 blocks, 2 aces, 18 kills and handled 40 of 41 serves without error in the two matches ... **Austin Matautia** had 9 kills vs. USC (2/13) ... he hit .400 with 8 kills in the win at BYU and added a team-high 9 kills in the loss ... **Kyle Vom Steeg** totaled 14 kills in a pair of starts at BYU, his first starts as a Bruin ... **Adam Parks** registered 2 block solos and 3 blocks assists versus USC (2/13) in a start at middle blocker ... **Sam Burgi** recorded a career-best six kills in a start against the Trojans (2/13) ... **Cole Pender** had 11 digs, one shy of his career best, in the 2021 opener against GCU ... Middle blocker **Daniel Matheney** put down a career-best 10 spikes versus GCU in the opener while hitting .500, recorded 15 kills and 8 blocks in the last 3 matches of 2020 ... **Cole Ketrzynski**, who was unavailable for the past three matches, paced UCLA with 13 kills in the opener against GCU ... His 17 kills in last season's win at Concordia which were the most by a Bruin true freshman since Micah Ma'a put down 18 balls against Hawai'i in Feb. 2016 ... The MPSF coaches picked UCLA to finish third in the league race this season, behind BYU and Pepperdine and just ahead of GCU ... The Bruins finished 2020 at No. 9 in the final AVCA Coaches poll after seeing their 2020 season end early due to the pandemic.

AT HOME -- The Bruins have split their first two home matches ... UCLA had an eight-match Pauley Pavilion win streak cancelled with the USC loss (2/13) ... Over the past five-plus seasons, UCLA is 41-6 in matches played in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom (2016: 10-1--lost to UCI, 2017: 8-1--CSUN, 2018: 13-2--Long Beach 2xs, 2019: 7-1--Long Beach; 2020: 2-0; 2021: 1-1--USC).

ON THE ROAD -- UCLA is 1-1 on the road this season after splitting a pair of matches at BYU.

NCAA STATS -- UCLA enters the week 13th in the nation in blocks (2.29), 14th in set assists (11.07) and 16th in kills at 11.79.

MPSF -- Details regarding the postseason MPSF Championship Tournament will be announced at a later date. Due to the possibility of an unbalanced number of matches this year, conference wins (NOT win percentage), will be the first criteria looked at to determine MPSF Tournament seeding. Conference win percentage will be the first tiebreaker.

- Austin Matautia** added nine kills vs. USC (2/13) ... hit .400 in win at BYU (2/4) ... hit .462 against GCU in season-opening contest with 8 kills ... Matautia was a starter in all 19 matches in 2020 ... had at least one ace in 15 of 19 matches in 2020 ... career-best four aces at G. Mason.
- Cole Pender** had an 11-dig effort vs. GCU, one shy of his career best of 12 vs. Pepperdine in 2019 ... saw action in 18 matches at libero and outside hitter in 2020 ... posted eight kills vs. USC in last season's match ... picked up aces against UC Santa Barbara and Grand Canyon.
- Sam Kobrine** put down career-best 14 kills vs. USC with 10 digs ... totaled a career-best 40 set assists against GCU ... appeared in 15 matches in 2020 and started last five ... had 2020 season-highs of 7 kills vs. Long Beach St. and 21 set assists in a couple of matches.
- Daniel Matheney** put away a career-best 10 kills in 2021 opener vs. Grand Canyon ... saw action in nine matches in 2020 with starts at UCSD, Penn St. and Ohio St. ... posted 2020 highs of 7 kills and 4 blocks vs. UC San Diego (h) ... had block solo in win vs. Ohio State.
- Freshman **Ethan Champlin** had 13 kills, 3 block solos vs. USC (2/13) ... was named Molten/MPSF Defensive Player of the Week (2/8) ... led UCLA with 11 kills in win at BYU (2/4) ... had 15 digs for the BYU matches and ranks 12th nationally at 2.30 digs/s... played setter, libero and outside hitter at Classical Academy HS.
- Adam Parks** made his first career starts at middle blocker at BYU and totaled 2 block solos and 4 block assists ... added two block solos and 3 block assists vs. USC (2/13) ... picked up 2 kills in work along the front row against GCU... Parks appeared in 7 matches at setter in 2020.
- Kyle Vom Steeg** made his first two career starts at BYU ... he delivered a career-best 9 kills in the win over the Cougars (2/4).
- Cole Ketrynski** was not available for the past three matches ... he had a 13-kill performance vs. Grand Canyon in the 2021 season-opener ... appeared in 15 matches last season with 12 starts ... had nine double-digit kill matches topped by 17-kill efforts in four matches ... his 17 kills in a match were the most by a Bruin true freshman since Micah Ma'a put down 18 balls against Hawai'i in 2016.
- Alex Knight** has not been available for first four matches of 2021 ... last season, he played in 16 matches (14 starts) ... season-high 15 kills against Princeton (h) ... had five double-digit kill matches ... season-best three aces vs. Ohio State ... high of 13 digs vs. Long Beach State (h).
- Merrick McHenry** picked up 6 kills and 2 blocks in his first career action and start against GCU ... he was not available the past three matches.
- Marcus Partain** saw his first career action in the matches at BYU (setter and server) ... had three kills, 22 set assists vs. USC (2/13).
- Sam Burgi** made first start of 2021 against USC (2/13) ... had career-best 6 kills ... appeared in 17 matches in 2020 with a start at Stanford.
- Ian Eschenberg** saw his first action of 2021 vs. USC and recorded an ace ... saw action in 4 matches in 2020 with best of 4 kills at Stanford.
- Kevin Kobrine** added a kill in the Saturday match at BYU ... he played in four 2020 matches and recorded season-best 4 kills at UC San Diego.
- J.R. Norris IV** appeared in 9 matches last season with starts at George Mason and at Daemen ... had season-best four kills vs. CSUN.
- Cole Power** tallied a season-best 13 digs last season in the win at Concordia and added seven more vs. USC.
- Grant Maleski**, who equaled his career-best with two block solos at Long Beach, saw action in 8 matches ... had season-high 3 kills vs. Princeton
- Freshman **Miles Partain** earned CIF All-City honors in three straight seasons 2017-19 while leading his Palisades HS team to three CIF City titles ... made the all-tournament at the 2019 Best of the West event ... on the beach, he was AVP 2019 Rookie of the Year.
- Freshman **Grant Sloane** was a top-five vote getter on the Volleyballmag.com Boys 25 Underclassmen to Watch list.
- UCLA, 2-1 in 2021, posted a 3-8 record in 2020 against teams ranked in the AVCA Coaches poll at the time of the match.

HEAD COACH JOHN SPERAW - YEAR NINE AT UCLA

John Speraw, who has produced three NCAA titles and a 2016 Olympic Bronze medal finish as a head coach, is set to begin his ninth season at the helm in Westwood. During his collegiate coaching career he has been named the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Coach of the Year, the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Coach of the Year and Volleyball Magazine Coach of the Year. Speraw was the first individual to win an NCAA MVB championship as a head coach (2007, 2009 and 2012 at UC Irvine), an assistant coach (1996, 1998, 2000 at UCLA) and as a player (1993 and 1995 at UCLA). He has guided the Bruins into the National Championship Tournament, including a trip to the Championship match in 2018. Speraw entered the 2021 season with a 348-190 overall collegiate record.

A member of the 2018 Class of the SoCal Indoor Volleyball Hall of Fame, Speraw achieved milestone wins No. 100 at UCLA and No. 300 overall during the 2018 campaign. In addition, he was named the 2018 VolleyballMag.com men's college Coach of the Year after leading his Bruins into the NCAA championship match. UCLA finished 26-8, the most wins by the program since 2006.

Speraw, voted the 2006 AVCA Coach of the Year, was named head coach at UCLA in June of 2012 and has tutored 41 All-Americans in his career. He came to UCLA from UC Irvine where he led the Anteaters to three NCAA titles, two Mountain Pacific Sports Federation regular season titles (2006, 2009) and two MPSF Tournament crowns (2007, 2012). He guided UCI to a 199-106 record in ten seasons.

Speraw has also enjoyed an extensive coaching resume with the U.S. Men's National team. After serving as Assistant Coach for the 2008 (Gold in Beijing) and 2012 Olympic Games (advanced to the quarterfinals at London), Speraw was elevated to head coach of the U.S. Men's Volleyball National Team in March of 2013. The U.S. qualified for the 2016 Olympic Games by winning the 2015 World Cup competition and went on to capture the Bronze medal at the Rio Games. In the summer of 2018, Speraw directed the U.S. Men's National Team to its first FIVB World Championship medal in 24 years when it beat Serbia for the bronze in Turin, Italy. The U.S. men have already qualified for the upcoming Tokyo Games, winning their Intercontinental Qualifying Pool during the summer of 2019.

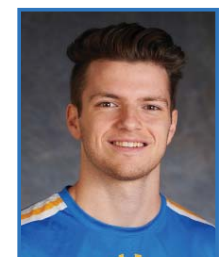
