



OREGON WOMEN'S BASKETBALL POSTGAME NOTES

#8 UCLA 83, #13 Oregon 56

#1 NYARA SABALLY (12 Pts, 5-6 FG)

- » Fourth straight double-figure scoring performance and team-leading 13th of the season (11th in Pac-12 play).
- » 3-of-3 from the floor and 1-of-1 from three-point range for eight of Oregon's 22 points in the third quarter.
- » Led Oregon in scoring for the
- » Started for the 15th time in 17 games played this season.

#12 TE-HINA PAO PAO (11 Pts, 4-7 FG, 3-5 3FG)

- » Scored in double figures for the 11th time this season, all coming in Pac-12 play.
- » 18th straight start to open her career; only Duck to start every game this season.
- » Made at least one three-pointer for the 14th time in 18 games, and three or more triples for the second straight game and sixth time this season.

#21 ERIN BOLEY (2 Pts, Reb, Stl)

- » Made her 17th start of the season, 88th as a Duck, and 98th of her collegiate career.

#4 JAZ SHELLEY (7 Pts, 3 Reb, Blk, Stl)

- » Had at least one steal for the 13th time this season.

#33 SYDNEY PARRISH (7 Pts, 2 Reb)

- » Started for the second straight game and the second time in her career.
- » Scored at least seven points for the ninth time this season.

#3 TAYLOR CHAVEZ (6 Pts, 4 Ast, 2 Stl, 2-4 3FG)

- » Returned to action for the first time since Jan. 24, playing 17 minutes off the bench.
- » Led Oregon in assists for the fourth time this season.
- » Made at least one three-pointer for the sixth time this season, and multiple triples for the second time.
- » Multiple steals for the second time this season.

#32 SEDONA PRINCE (5 Pts, Blk, Stl)

- » Has blocked at least one shot in 12 of 13 games played this season.

#11 TAYLOR MIKESELL (2 Pts)

- » Made her 14th start this season and 80th of her career.
