KEY STORYLINES

DUCKS RETURN TO ACTION FOR HOME, PAC-12 OPENER

The Ducks will be back on the field competing for the first time since Feb. 28 on Saturday when they host California in their 2021 home and Pac-12 opener at Pape Field. Oregon had two weeks off following its overtime loss at Central Michigan, and then had to cancel its games at Colorado (March 12) and Denver (March 14) because of COVID-19 protocols. Saturday's game is the first of six home games for the Ducks during this unique 2021 season, with No. 20 Stanford set to come to Eugene on Monday.

SERIES HISTORY VS. CALIFORNIA

Oregon owns a 14-9 lead in the all-time series with California, winning the most recent matchup - a 12-8 victory in Eugene on April 12, 2019 - to record the first career Pac-12 victory for head coach Chelsea Hoffmann. The Ducks are 10-3 against the Golden Bears since the start of the 2011 season, and Oregon has won each of the last four meetings in Eugene.

HEARTBREAKER IN MICHIGAN

Oregon put together its most complete performance so far this season on Feb. 28 in Mount Pleasant, Mich., but the Ducks came up just short in a bid for their first win of 2021 as Central Michigan escaped with a 12-11 overtime victory. Oregon took a 7-6 lead into halftime before the Chippewas moved ahead 11-9, but goals from **HANNA HILCOFF** and **LILLIAN STUMP** pulled the Ducks back even and forced the game into overtime. UO looked to have its first win of the season on a goal from **MORGAN MCCARTHY** in the first three minutes of overtime, but the score was waved off because of a dangerous follow through. The Chippewas then found the back of the net with 34 seconds left in the period to escape with a victory. Hilcoff and Stump each recorded hat tricks for the Ducks, and both McCarthy and **LINDSAY CLARKE** - who made her first career start - added two goals.

HILCOFF PICKING UP RIGHT WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

HANNA HILCOFF made an immediate impact for the Ducks last season as a freshman, and the Jupiter, Fla., native has picked up where she left off through the first four games of her sophomore season. Hilcoff scored two goals in each of Oregon's first two games before accounting for all of UO's offense with four goals on Feb. 26 at Marquette, and she added a hat trick on Feb. 28 at Central Michigan. Hilcoff now owns six career games with a hat trick or better, and she has scored multiple goals in 10 of her first 11 games to open her collegiate career. Hilcoff also leads Oregon with 13 total draw controls so far this season, sixth-most in the Pac-12.

Last season, Hannah Hilcoff...

» Was one of 15 players and one of only three freshmen nationally to record at least 20 goals (22) and 40 draw controls (44).

» Led Oregon and ranked second in the Pac-12 in both goals and draw controls.

» Became the first freshman to lead Oregon in goals since Shannon Williams in 2016.

» Ranked second nationally among freshmen in draw controls while ranking fourth in goals and sixth in points (26).

» Finished with four hat tricks, headlined by a UO single-game record-tying seven-goal performance in the 2020 finale vs. Fresno State.

» Matched the UO single-game record with 10 draw controls on 2/21/20 at No. 10 Denver.

CAREER DAY FOR GIERKE IN MICHIGAN

Junior Logan Gierke - a team captain for Oregon on the defensive end - enjoyed a career performance the last time the Ducks took the field. Gierke racked up a career-high five caused turnovers at Central Michigan to become the first Duck since March 2017 with four or more caused turnovers in a game, and she also led the Ducks with a career-best six ground balls. Gierke has six total caused turnovers on the season, tied for the second-most in the Pac-12.

DUNBAR RACKING UP THE SAVES

Senior goalkeeper **ALLE DUNBAR** has been racking up saves through the first four games of her senior season, ranking third in the Pac-12 with 44 total entering Saturday's home opener. Dunbar entered 2021 with a career-high of 12 saves - done in the 2020 season finale vs. Fresno State - and has bested that mark twice already this season with 13 in the season opener at SDSU and 14 on Feb. 26 at Marquette. Dating back to 2020, Dunbar has recorded 56 total saves in her last five games.

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

The Ducks started three true freshmen midfielders - **HALEY CUMMINS**, **NAKEEYA MCCARDELL** and **MORGAN MCCARTHY** - in each of the first four games of the season, and freshman attacker Lindsay Clarke joined that mix on Feb. 28 at Central Michigan with her first career start. Clarke, McCardell and McCarthy each have three goals apiece so far this season while Cummins has two, and the quartet has combined for 14 total points, 15 ground balls and six caused turnovers through four games.

▶ HEAD COACH CHELSEA HOFFMANN



Chelsea Hoffmann - previously Chelsea Gamble - was named the third head coach in Oregon lacrosse history on August 1, 2018, after a highly successful four-year stint as an assistant coach at Pac-12 rival Stanford.

In her first season as a head coach in 2019, Hoffmann led the Ducks to a 3-15 overall record. The Ducks got off to a 2-5 start in Hoffmann's second season and were coming off a 20-goal performance in a win over Fresno State when the 2021 season came to a halt due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Hoffmann installed a new offense less than 48 hours before the game vs. the Bulldogs, and the result was a 12-goal first half and 12 total goals from freshman Hannah Hilcoff and sophomore Shonly Wallace. Hilcoff (22) and Wallace (20) were the only duo in the Pac-12 to each score at least 20 goals in the shortened 2020 campaign.

Before Oregon, as the offensive coordinator for the Cardinal from 2015 to 2018, Hoffmann helped lead Stanford to a pair of conference championships, including the inaugural Pac-12 Tournament title in 2018, and three NCAA appearances. Stanford had reached the NCAA Tournament just five times prior to Hoffmann's arrival.

Under Hoffmann's guidance, the Cardinal offense led the Pac-12 in points per game (21.25), goals per game (15.15) and assists per game (6.10) in 2018, while also pacing the league in ground balls (21.55) and draw controls per game (15.00). Nationally, Stanford tied for 14th in goals per game and was 10th in scoring margin (5.75). The Cardinal also thrived academically in 2018, leading the nation with 10 student-athletes on the IWLCA academic honor roll.

The Stanford offense ranked among the top 15 in the nation in scoring every year under Hoffmann's direction, highlighted by a 2015 season that saw Hoffmann orchestrate the nation's top scoring offense (16.00 goals per game) as 11 Cardinal scored 10 or more goals. Stanford also led the nation in draw controls that year (15.28 per game) en route to a perfect 9-0 conference record, an MPSF Conference title and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

Hoffmann arrived at Stanford from Connecticut, where she was an assistant the previous three seasons (2012-14). The Huskies enjoyed unprecedented success during her tenure, setting consecutive school records for victories in 2012 and 2013 and advancing to the program's first NCAA Tournament in 2013.

As a freshman midfielder at George Mason, Hoffmann played under current Stanford head coach Amy Bokker and was named to the Colonial Athletic Association All-Rookie team. Hoffmann was named captain as a sophomore and held that post for three seasons, earning All-CAA honors along the way.
