FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- » Utah baseball stays on the road for the third series in a row and will take on a familiar foe in No. 22 Arizona State for a non-conference three-game series. The Utes and Sun Devils were set to begin Pac-12 play last season, but the series was canceled and then shortly after the rest of the season was canceled.
- » Utah sits at 1-5 on the season after getting swept by Loyola Marymount in Los Angeles, Calif. This will be the first series Utah has played outside of the state of California.
- » The Utes did have some big innings against LMU, where they scored at least five runs. In the first game, they scored six runs in the sixth inning to get back in the game. They sent 11 to the plate that inning. The next day, they scored five runs in the seventh inning to get back in the game.
- » Kayler Yates leads Utah hitting .313. He has three RBI and is leading Utah in slugging percentage at .563.
- » Jaylon McLaughlin was on the bases consistently against LMU. He totaled four hits over the weekend with three of those being extra base hits. McLaughlin also had three RBI on the weekend.

FIRST PITCH

Utah baseball will head to Phoenix, Ariz. to take on the No. 22 Arizona State Sun Devils for a three-game non-conference series.

Arizona State is 5-2 on the season and Utah comes into the weekend with a 1-5 record.

The Utes have played CS Fullerton and Loyola Marymount the first weekend, so this will be their first trip not to California.

Utah and Arizona State were set to begin Pac-12 play last season when the series and ultimately the season was canceled.

MCLAUGHLIN LEADS OFF

Jaylon McLaughlin was on the bases quite a bit against LMU and triggered a big seventh inning for Utah in the first game. He led the inning off with a double triggering a six-run inning for Utah.

The Utes ended up batting around that inning and he singled later in the inning for the utes to score their sixth run of the inning.

Overall, McLaughlin had a triple and two doubles in the series. He also had three RBI.

THOMPSON HAS THREE RBI IN WIN

Tyler Thompson had a great start to the season hitting a team-leading .333 in the opening weekend.

On Sunday, he went 2-5 with two doubles with one of them clearing the bases. His three RBI in the game was a career high and helped Utah clinch their first win of the season.

TRANSFERS MAKE MARK

Matthew Sox, a transfer from Whitman, entered in relief against CS Fullerton and helped the Utes get out of a jam allowing him to get his first win at Utah.

To preserve the win, Brayson Hurdsmann came in and pitched the final 2.1 innings to get his first save in a Utah uniform. Hurdsmann transferred from Houston with plenty of experience under his belt and should be a staple at the back end of the bullpen for the season.

KAI ROBERTS MAKES STRONG DEBUT

Kai Roberts started all three games at third base for Utah on the opening weekend. He had a productive time in the field and at the plate.

Roberts hit .300 in the opening weekend scoring two runs with three hits.



In the final play on Monday, he made a great play at third to throw the runner out to secure the 6-5 win over CS Fullerton.

DEPTH AND EXPERIENCE

The Utes return almost everyone back from last year's team while adding in some talented newcomers giving them depth across the board.

On the pitching staff, they're led by Justin Kelly and David Watson, while they plenty of other options at starter with Kyle Robeniol returning for an extra year and Dustyn Schramm having plenty of experience.

In the infield, Utah has several players that can play multiple positions in Chase Fernlund, Shea Kramer and Matt Richardson.

Outfield wise, the Utes also have plenty of options between Isaac Deveaux, Vinny Zavolta, Tyler Thompson and Shea Kramer.

TRANSFERS WITH EXPERIENCE

Utah picked up two graduate transfers with plenty of experience to boost their outfield and bullpen.

Jaylon McLaughlin transferred in from Nevada and will bat leadoff while holding down the center field position. He had a breakout season for the Wolf Pack in 2019 leading the team with a career-high .339 batting average and was named first-team All-Mountain West after batting .360 in conference. His 25 stolen bases on the year ranked as the sixth-most in a single season by a Nevada player.

Brayson Hurdsmann transferred in from Houston and seen action in 62 games with a 3.83 ERA.

KELLY LEADS THE STARTERS

Redshirt sophomore Justin Kelly returned in 2020 after sitting out the 2019 season with an elbow injury. Kelly became the Friday night starter and that's the role he'll continue in this season.

His ERA ended up being the second best on the team at 2.66 and he only allowed seven earned runs in his four starts. Kelly pitched at least 6.0 innings in three of his four starts and pitched 5.1 innings in the other game.

This season, he holds a 5.40 ERA in 10 innings pitched.

In his freshman season, he appeared in 12 games out of the bullpen and held a 6.66 ERA. In 24.1 innings pitched, he had 23 strikeouts.

BROCOFF BACK FROM INJURY

Brett Brocoff is back from an elbow injury has pitched really well out of the bullpen so far this season.

In 3.0 innings pitched, he hasn't given up a run and struck out three batters. Brocoff has only given up one hit this season.

HEAVY ROAD SCHEDULE EARLY

Utah will play 14 of their first 16 games on the road this season.

Their first game will be against BYU on March 11 and March 12. Then, they'll host Dixie State for a midweek game before hosting Cal for the first home series of the season beginning on March 26.

Overall, the Utes have 25 home games scheduled.

VERSATILITY ACROSS THE INFIELD

Utah comes into the season with three players on its infield being able to play multiple positions.

Chase Fernlund played every spot in the infield in 2019 and has started mostly at second this season.

Shea Kramer is another ultimate utility player being able to play first, third or either corner outfield spot. Kramer played primarily at first during the 2019 season.

Matt Richardson started mostly at shortstop his freshman and sophomore season, but can also slide over and play second like he did the first weekend against CS Fullerton.

Jayden Kiernan also can play multiple positions and has started at first and catcher in his career.

UP NEXT

The Utes will play their first home games of the season against BYU beginning on Thursday, March 11. The Utes and Cougars will play a three-game series with two games being at Smith's Ballpark and one down in Provo at Larry Miller Field.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.
