CJ Davis poured in 15 points, Stan McNeil 11.

### NOTES

- Union, the No. 4 seed trailed most of the contest but threatened late in a first round NCCAA National Tournament loss to No. 4 seed Point Loma (Calif.) Nazarene 69-67 Wednesday afternoon in Winona Lake, Ind. Ashanti Day picked up the first two fouls of the game, the second with 17:53 to go until halftime and did not reappear until the start of the second half. The Sea Lions ended the first half on an 11-1 run to lead 34-25 at the break. Union ended the last 2:59 on a 14-1 spurt, but were on the short side of a 69-67 final. Day topped Union with 19 points.
- Union has four players scoring in double digits, led by Corieon Pearson at 17.3 points-per-game. AJ Roberts is scoring 14.3 ppg, Day 12.2 and Roy Bullock 11.1.
- Of the Bulldogs 29 games 17 have been decided by 10 points or less. Union is 8-9 in those games and 5-6 in games of five points or fewer.
- Carver won the NCCAA South Region. The No. 8 seed Cougars opened the NCCAA National Tournament with a 74-63 loss to No. 1 seed Southern Nazarene. Carver led Southern Nazarene 35-32 at halftime as Julian Bratton scored 11 first half points. The Cougars had four players reach double figures. Carver was led by Troy Swanson who made 8-of-16 shots and finished with 17 points. Derek Douglas scored 14 points, Julian Bratton ended with 13, while Christopher Datcher wound up scoring 12 points and a game high 11 rebounds.
