### **WILDCATS TAKE FIRST NSIC ROAD TRIP THIS WEEKEND, VISITING MINNESOTA CROOKSTON AND BEMIDJI STATE**

**THE MATCHUPS:** Wayne State will hit the road this weekend for their first Northern Sun Conference road trip, visiting Minnesota Crookston Friday evening at 8 p.m. and Bemidji State Saturday in a 6 p.m. contest.

The Wildcats are 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the NSIC following a split at home last weekend, beating Concordia-St. Paul 84-76 followed by a 76-59 loss to Minnesota State.

Wayne State men's basketball can be heard on local radio and the Wildcat Sports Network and flagship radio station KTCH FM 104.9/KCTY 1590 AM-98.9 FM in Wayne. Aaron Scheffler, Voice of the Wildcats, will call this weekend's action with Friday's game on 98.9 FM 'The City' and Saturday's game on 'Big Red Country' 104.9 FM.

**WILDCATS SPLIT NSIC HOME GAMES VS. CONCORDIA, MINNESOTA STATE:** Wayne State earned a home split on the first weekend of doubleheader conference play as the Wildcats topped Concordia-St. Paul Friday night 84-76 followed by a 76-59 loss to Minnesota State.

The Wildcats used a game-high 27 points from sophomore guard Matt Thomas in Friday's win over the Golden Bears. The game featured nine ties and eight lead changes. Austin Esters added 13 points with Jordan Cornelius and Joel Heesch also reaching double digits with 11 and 10 respectively.

WSC made 29 of 61 shots from the field for 47.5 percent, going 8 of 22 from behind the arc and 18 of 24 (75%) at the charity stripe. The 'Cats were out-rebounded by a 39-29 margin despite seven boards from Heesch.

Saturday's game saw Wayne State go 8:30 down the stretch without a basket as the Mavericks pulled away for the 76-59 win. The Wildcats trailed 51-48 with just under 13:00 left when going cold from the field. Thomas led WSC in scoring with 12 points while Adam Moon added 10.

WSC was 22 for 47 from the field (46.8%), 4 of 15 from the 3-point line (26.7%) and 11 of 17 (64%) at the free throw line. MSU out-rebound the 'Cats 34-25 with Cornelius grabbing seven boards for Wayne State.

**ABOUT WAYNE STATE:** The Wildcats are 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the NSIC entering this weekend's NSIC road trip to Minnesota Crookston and Bemidji State. WSC is 2-2 at home, 0-2 on the road and 0-1 in neutral court games this season.

Wayne State averages 75 points a game while allowing 84.4. The 'Cats are shooting 45.6 percent from the field, 30.1 percent behind the arc and 67.1 percent from the charity stripe. WSC has a rebounding margin of -5.0 through seven games. The Wildcats rank second in the NSIC in blocked shots per game (3.7), third in turnovers forced per game (13.43), eighth in turnover margin (-0.4) and ninth in steals per game (5.1).

Individually for the Wildcats, sophomore Matt Thomas leads Wayne State in scoring at 18.3 points per game to rank sixth in the NSIC. He has three games of 25 or more points this season and is seventh in the league in free throw percentage at 83.3 percent (35-42). Sophomore forward Jordan Cornelius is second in scoring at 9.6 points to go with a team-leading 5.0 rebounds per contest.

Junior guard Joel Heesch produces 9.3 points and 4.4 rebounds a game with sophomore reserve guard Austin Esters at 8.6 points a game. Redshirt freshman forward Adam Moon rounds out the top five scorers for WSC at 6.0 points a contest.

**DID YOU KNOW???:** Home teams are 13-9 so far in the NSIC this season.

**WAYNE STATE HEAD COACH BRIAN DOLAN:** Brian Dolan enters his third season as Head Men's Basketball Coach at Wayne State College. He was introduced as the 26th coach in program history on July 18, 2013.



Dolan coached a youthful (eight freshmen) Wildcat squad to a 7-22 overall record in 2014-15, going 4-18 in the NSIC. One of the highlight wins during the season was an 81-79 victory over Winona State, snapping an 18-game losing streak to the Warriors that covered 10 years (January 14, 2005).

In his first season (2013-14) at the helm, Dolan guided the Wildcats to a 9-19 overall record and a 5-17 mark in the NSIC. WSC recorded arguably the biggest upset in the first round history of the NSIC Sanford Health Men's Basketball Tournament with an 88-76 win at NSIC North Division Co-Champion Bemidji State to highlight Dolan's inaugural season with the Wildcats.

Dolan came to Wayne State after serving at Upper Iowa for seven seasons where he helped transition the program from NCAA Division III to NCAA Division II and the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. In his last season at Upper Iowa (2012-13), Dolan led the Peacocks to a 20-12 overall record and an appearance in the NCAA Division II National Tournament, the schools' first ever trip to the NCAA Division II post season. In his seven seasons at Upper Iowa, Dolan coached the Peacocks to a 67-127 record.

Prior to arriving at Upper Iowa, Dolan also served as an assistant coach at Texas-Pan American (2004-06). He spent the 2003-04 season at the College of Southern Idaho where he led the team to the Region 18 Tournament Title and a trip to the National Junior College Men's Basketball Tournament. Dolan's squad finished that year 24-11 after falling in the second round of the tournament. While at Southern Idaho, Dolan also served as the teams academic and recruiting coordinator.

From 2001-03 Dolan was at Southern Utah and in his final season at the school helped the team to the semifinals of the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament. He also spent one season (2000-01) at Southwest Missouri State where his team finished second in the Missouri Valley Conference going 23-11 and reaching the second round of the National Invitation Tournament. Dolan also served as an administrative assistant at Oral Roberts (1998-99) under Barry Hinson. Dolan is a 1998 graduate of William Jewell College in Liberty, Missouri.

Brian Dolan resides in Wayne with his wife Kristen. They have five children - Cole Leonard (17), Hannah Leonard (14), Pryor Dolan (11), Reagan Dolan (8) and Major Dolan (3).

**ABOUT MINNESOTA CROOKSTON:** The Golden Eagles are 2-5 overall and 0-3 in the NSIC entering Friday's game vs. the Wildcats. UMC is 0-1 at home, 1-4 in road games and 1-0 on a neutral court.

Minnesota Crookston dropped NSIC road games last weekend at Minnesota Duluth (78-71) and St. Cloud State (97-68). UMC owns wins at Wisconsin-Stout 74-51 and vs. Valley City State 63-60.

UMC averages 68.9 points a game while giving up 72. The Golden Eagles shoot 43.3 percent from the field, 37.3 percent behind the 3-point line and 70.4 percent from the foul line. Minnesota Crookston has a rebounding margin of -7.3.

Senior guard Derrick Redd tops the Golden Eagles in scoring averaging 14.9 points a game. Sophomore guard C.J. Polk adds 9.3 a contest with junior forward Ben Grygiel producing 8.9 points a game to go with a team-high 4.3 rebounds a contest. Freshman guard Kobe Critchley leads the Golden Eagles in assists with 16 and scores 7.0 points a game.

**WAYNE STATE VS. MINNESOTA CROOKSTON SERIES HISTORY:** The Wildcats hold a 22-6 lead in the all-time series against Minnesota Crookston that began in the 1999-2000 season when UMC joined the NSIC. Last season, Minnesota Crookston snapped a five-game losing streak in the series with a 61-57 win in Wayne.

WSC has won their last two trips to Crookston, winning 66-41 in the 2012-13 season and 53-44 in 2011-12. The Wildcats also beat UMC in the 2013-14 season 65-51 in Wayne.

**ABOUT BEMIDJI STATE:** The Beavers are 4-3 on the year and 1-2 in the NSIC entering this weekend's play. BSU is 3-1 at home and 1-2 in road games this season.

Bemidji State dropped NSIC road games last weekend at St. Cloud State 80-62 and at Minnesota Duluth 74-67.

BSU averages 74.3 points a game while allowing 63.9. The Beavers make 43.7 percent from the field, 29.8 percent behind the arc and just 60.7 percent at the charity stripe. Bemidji State holds a rebounding margin of +2.4 through seven games.

Junior forward Ben Best leads Bemidji State in scoring (13.6) and rebounding (6.7), shooting 63.5 percent from the field. He also has a team-best 10 blocked shots.

Senior guard DJ Anderson scores 10.3 points a game and averages 3.57 assists per game. Junior guard Elijah Valdez averages 9.0 points a game and has made a team-high 14 3-pointers.

**WAYNE STATE VS. BEMIDJI STATE SERIES HISTORY:** Wayne State holds a 27-20 lead in the all-time series against Bemidji State despite the Beavers winning six of the last eight meetings dating back to 2011.

Last season, Bemidji State posted a 87-80 win over the Wildcats in Wayne. Two years ago, the Wildcats shocked NSIC North Division champion Bemidji State 88-76 in the first round of the NSIC Tournament in Bemidji (2/26/14) after the Beavers won convincingly in Wayne 69-46 in the regular season. WSC also lost at BSU in the 2012-13 season 71-54.
