COUGARS HEAD TO HOUSTON FOR PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS

Washington State (4-1) heads to Houston for the Pac-12 Conference Championships beginning Wednesday evening. The event was originally scheduled to be hosted in Federal Way, Wash.

COUGS AT THE PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS

WSU is looking to improve on last season's score of 396, over a 100-point improvement from the prior season and the second-highest point total in the last 15 seasons.

WSU EARNED CSCAA SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Washington State earned CSCAA Scholar All-America Team Honors after posting a 3.61 GPA in the Fall 2020 semester. The Cougars earned the honor for the ninth straight semester including all five under head coach Matt Leach.

LARSON BREAKS OWN POOL RECORD, WSU BEATS IDAHO ON SENIOR NIGHT

Senior Chloe Larson highlighted an impressive senior night performance for WSU, breaking her own Gibb Pool record in the Cougars' 162-98 victory over Idaho. WSU (4-1) claimed 13 of the 14 races as seniors Mackenzie Duarte (100 breast, 200 breast, 100 IM) and Taylor McCoy (400 IM, 100 back, 200 back) tied for the team-lead with three wins a piece while freshmen Jose Liezeit and Kiana Swain each posted wins in the 200 free and 200 fly, respectively. Larson, who broke the pool record in the 50 free two weeks ago, surpassed her own mark by .11 and also notched her second NCAA B time of the season while claiming the 50 free. Freshman Hailey Grotte won the 100 free and fellow freshman newcomer Kaya Takashige won the 100 fly. Washington State also won both relay events (400 medley and 200 free relay).

COUGARS POST ROAD VICTORY AT SEATTLE U

Washington State claimed nine races in route to a 161-100 win at Seattle University Saturday. The Cougars remained perfect in the all-time series with the Redhawks, posting their ninth straight win against SU. Senior Taylor McCoy recorded a pair of wins in the 200 free and 200 IM to push her season win total to a team-best six. WSU opened with meet with a win in the 200 medley relay, freshman Josie Liezeit followed with a win in the 1000 free, McCoy added a win in the 200 free and freshman Hailey Grotte won the 100 breast. A pair of underclassmen recorded their first collegiate wins as sophomore Jewel Springer won the 200 fly and freshman Kaya Takashige claimed the 50 free.

COUGARS BATTLE UTAH, LARSON SETS GIBB POOL RECORD

Washington State claimed seven races including a record-setting win by senior Chloe Larson in the Cougars 140-118 defeat to Utah in the Pac-12 Conference opener. WSU received a pair of wins from Michee Van Rooyen in the 200 Free and 500 Free while Larson posted wins in the 50 Free and 100 Free. Larson, a senior from Rapid City, S.D., put her name atop the Gibb Pool record book with a 22.70 time to win the 50 free, breaking Canadian Olympian Taylor Ruck's mark she set while competing for Stanford in 2018. The Cougars also received a win from freshman Kiana Swain in the 200 Fly, the eighth-fastest 200 fly time in program-history (2:03.74).

COUGARS OPENED SEASON WITH TWO WINS AT IDAHO

Washington State opened the 2020-21 season with a pair of wins at Idaho in November. In the opener, the Cougars recorded seven wins in the 13 events lead by Taylor McCoy's victories in the 200 IM and 400 IM. The following day, WSU recorded wins in all four events as McCoy won the 200 back, Chloe Larson won the 100 free, Mackenzie Duarte won the 200 breast and Mia Zahab ended the meet with a win in the 200 fly.

FOUR COUGS NOTCH OLYMPIC TRIAL TIMES

Mackenzie Duarte ended last winter's 2019 U.S. Open earning an Olympic Trial Cut time in the 200 breast to send her to Omaha. Duarte joined Cougar teammates Taylor McCoy (200 back) and Lauren Burckel (200 breast, 100 breast) who also recorded Olympic Trial cut times during the 2019 summer. The 2020 U.S. Olympic Team Trials have been rescheduled for the 2021 summer in Omaha, Neb. Mia Zahab recorded Olympic Trial times for Team Canada in seven events.

KATE MOORE NAMED ASSISTANT COACH

Kate Moore was announced as the Cougars' assistant coach Aug. 21. Moore joined WSU after spending the previous 10 seasons as a member of the East Carolina University Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving coaching staff following a decorated career as a student-athlete at ECU. Moore worked the prior three seasons as ECU's associate head coach, the previous two seasons as the head assistant coach and prior five seasons as an assistant coach. During Moore's time on the staff, the Pirates won four American Athletic Conference titles, sent nine athletes to the NCAA Championships and helped ECU claim 41 individual conference titles and 21 relay championships. A native of Pottstown, Pa., Moore was a four-time all-conference performer, championship finalist and US Open qualifier.

COUGARS INK FIVE TO NLI

Washington State signed five to National Letters of Intent Nov. 13. The Cougars added Noelle Harvey, Sophie Macy, Noelle Marsh, Ilaria Moro and Taylor Schababerle each signed NLI's to join the Cougars next fall. **Noelle Harvey** is a native of Carlsbad, Calif. and swims the freestyle and backstroke for La Costa Canyon High School and North Coast Aquatics. **Sophie Macy** is a native of Chanhassen, Minn. and is expected to swim the backstroke. **Noelle Marsh** is a native of Magnolia, Texas and swims sprint freestyle for the Magnolia Aquatic Club. **Ilaria Moro** is out of Gigliano, Italy and swims the butterfly for Sinsport Rane Rosee club team. **Taylor Schababerle** is out of Katy, Texas and swims the freestyle for James Taylor High School and Katy Aquatics.

Matt Leach is in his third season leading the Washington State University Women's Swimming program after being hired July 19, 2018.

In his second season leading the Cougars, Leach continued the impressive trend of posting record-setting times, earning trips to the postseason and success in the classroom. The 2019-20 team set three school-records, recorded 21 Top-10 times, post their second-highest point total at the Pac-12 Conference Championships in the last 13 seasons and saw 10 swimmers earn a trip to the postseason CSCAA National Invitational Championships. Leach also saw four Cougars post 2020 (2021) Olympic Qualifying Times in Lauren Burckel (USA), Mackenzie Duarte (USA), Taylor McCoy (USA) and Mia Zahab (Canada). In the classroom, eight student-athletes were named to the Pac-12 Conference Academic Winter Honor Roll while as a team, WSU earned CSCAA Scholar All-America Team Honors in the fall and capped the school year with a 3.54 Spring Team GPA, the highest semester GPA in the previous 10 years.

Leach guided his young Cougar team to a number of accomplishments in his first season at WSU highlighted by producing the program's first NCAA National Championship participant in sophomore Mackenzie Duarte since 2010. Leach also led the Cougars to the postseason, finishing eighth at the CSCAA National Invitational Championships including an individual title by Linnea Lindberg in the 50 breaststroke. The Cougars reached many milestones under Leach in 2018-19, posted ten WSU Top-10 times at the Pac-12 Conference Championships, set two school records in the 100 free and 200 breast through the year, three different swimmers recorded double-digit wins and as a team were ranked second in the Pac-12 based on improvement from the year prior, according to SwimSwam.com. Academically, WSU earned CSCAA Scholar All-America Team honors (Team GPA of 3.00+) in the fall and spring, three swimmers earned CSCAA Scholar All-American honorable mention accolades and eight earned Pac-12 All-Academic honors including a pair of first-team selections.

Leach joined WSU after spending the previous three years at Indiana State where he started the swimming and diving programs in 2015 and began competing in the 2016-17 season. In the program's second season, Leach was named the 2017-18 Missouri Valley Coach of the Year after guiding the Sycamores to a 13-win campaign that featured a 10-dual match win streak and a record-setting team performance at the Missouri Valley Conference Championships where ISU set school records in every event, highlighted by the program's first individual conference champion. Nine Sycamores earned All-MVC honors including a trio of first-team selections.

Out of the pool, Leach saw his team earn CSCAA Scholar All-American honors for the third straight semester, including the highest team GPA in the Missouri Valley Conference. Six student-athletes earned MVC All-Academic honors this past season after five earned the same honor in 2016-17.

Prior to Indiana State, Leach spent six seasons at the University of Wyoming (2009-15), including the final four seasons as associate head coach and worked extensively with sprint swimmers. Leach helped rewrite the Cowgirl record books, as every sprint event school record was broke during his time on staff. He has also coached sprint swimmers to NCAA and Olympic trials competitions including two-time All-America selection Kelsey Conci who earned trips to the NCAA Championships in the 100 backstroke and the 50 and 100 freestyle, placing 10th in the 100 backstroke at the 2011 NCAA Championships and ninth at the 2012 championships.

Leach arrived at Wyoming from Louisiana State University where he began as a graduate assistant in 2004, and then as a volunteer assistant coach for two seasons (2007-09). At LSU, Leach helped guide several athletes to the NCAA Championships, and a top-25 ranking for both the men's and women's teams. Leach also served as the head age group coach at Tiger Aquatics from 2006-09 where he was named the 2007 Louisiana State Age Group Coach of the Year for his efforts in his first season.

A native of Portland, Ore., Leach swam collegiately at Indiana University (2000-04), where he was a four-time All-American, helped the Hoosiers to a Big Ten Conference Championship in the 200 medley relay as a senior and still holds school records as a member of the 200 freestyle relay and 400 medley relay. Leach also performed on the national stage, as he took part in the 2000 and 2004 U.S. Olympic Trials.

Leach graduated from Indiana in December 2004 with a bachelor's degree in environmental management. He received his master's degree, also in environmental planning and management, from LSU in May 2007. Leach and his wife, Katie welcomed their daughter Eloise in 2019.
